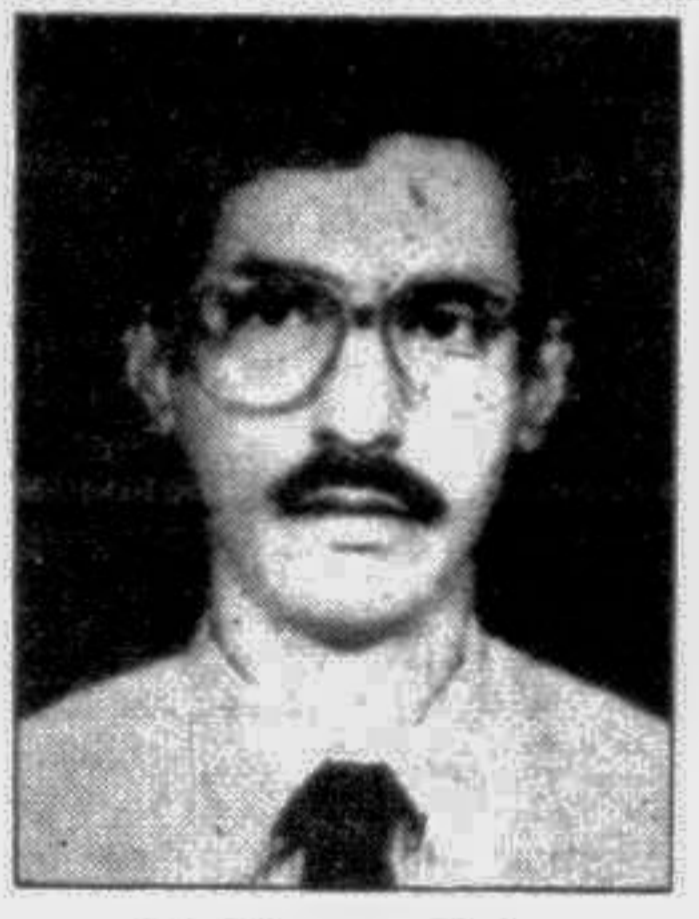

Azam's trial inconsistent with Rule Of Law: Salam

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Abdus Salam Talukder Monday called upon the BNP leaders and workers to work untidely in order to expedite the socio-economic development of the country by implementing the 19-point programmes of BNP initiated by Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman, reports BSS. He was addressing a discussion and iftar party, arranged by Keraniganj Jatiyatubadi Jubo Dal at Zinzira Community Centre. State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock and Environment and forest Gayeshwar Roy and local BNP leaders also spoke on the occasion. The minister referred to the influx of Rohingya refugees into Bangladesh and the trial of Golan Azam. He said the BNP government believed in solving these problems peacefully. He said the government had already sought international assistance to solve the Rohingya refugee problem. He said the question of trial of Golan Azam in the People's Court is not in conformity with the concept of Rule Of Law. The minister said the opposition political parties wanted to create chaos and political instability in the country by taking law in their own hands. He called upon the workers and leaders of Jatiyatubadi Jubo Dal to maintain peace and discipline under all circumstances and to lead the country to progress and prosperity through their spontaneous participation in the development activities.

Progressive development of Meteorological science underscored

World Meteorological Day was observed in Bangladesh Monday as elsewhere in the world, reports BSS. Bangladesh Meteorological Department chalked out an elaborate programme in observance of the day. The day was observed in keeping with the theme "Weather and climate services for sustainable development" which was chosen by the World Meteorological Organisation for 1992. The day's programme included discussion and seminar on the significance of World Meteorological Day and exhibition of meteorological equipment and weather charts at different places of the country. A discussion was held at the Meteorological Department at Agargaon on "Weather and climate services for sustainable development". Inaugurating the discussion Secretary of the Science and Technology Division Hesham Uddin Ahmed emphasised the need for popularising meteorology science and inspiring the youths to learn this science. He underscored the need for progressive development of meteorological science in Bangladesh along with the development of technical and procedural systems in weather forecasting. In his presidential speech at the discussion Director of the Meteorological Department M H Khan Chowdhury said the meteorological scientists were continuing their climatological research and did not find any alarming change in the climate. He said the government had undertaken programmes to connect the radar stations at Khepupara and Cox's Bazar through micro wave links with the Storm Warning Centre in Dhaka. He said modern computers had been set up for data analysis and developed communications system. Deputy Director of the Meteorological Department M F Quyyum also spoke. The discussion was followed by a scientific seminar at the Met office which was also presided over by the Director of the Department M H Khan Chowdhury. An exhibition of meteorological equipment and charts was held at premises of the Met Department. Similar exhibitions were also held at different meteorological offices in the country including Chittagong, Khulna, Sylhet, Rangpur and Rajshahi.



Fellowship

Pradip Kumar Daw from Calcutta, India received a fellowship of Asian Astrologers' Congress and Bangladesh National Astrologers Federation recently. The fellowship which was offered to only two more astrologers from Asia simultaneously, was offered to him at the fifth Asian Astrologers' conference jointly organised by the Asian Astrologers' Congress and Bangladesh Astrologers' Federation. Pradip Kumar Daw, a promising Astrologer, had been studying the subject for 18 years. He had earned national and international fame and received gold medal.

GCO protests Khatib's speech

By DU Correspondent The Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) at a rally in front of the National Press Club Monday demanded expulsion of the Khatib of Baitul Mukarram Mosque immediately. Addressing the rally, the GCO leaders Belal Chowdhury and Bidhan Roy condemned the speech made by the Khatib openly in support of Jamaat-Shibir and Golan Azam bloc. The GCO rally supporting the public trial of Golan Azam on March 26 also demanded ban on politics in all the religious centres including mosques, churches and temples. The leaders urged students including the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) to be cautious about the public trial. Earlier the GCO brought out a grand procession from the Madhu's Canteen of the Dhaka University which marched the city streets and dispersed at the National Press Club.

Rotary Int'l confce April 17

A three-day Rotary International Presidents' Conference of Cooperation and Goodwill for five designated countries — Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka — will begin here on April 17, reports UNB. Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia will inaugurate the conference to be presided over by Rotary International President Rajendra K Saboo. This is the first time Bangladesh will host a major Rotary International Conference designed to promote goodwill and mutual cooperation in the region. The conference is also aimed at considering ways and means for Rotary to foster peace and progress, giving special emphasis on functional literacy as means of economic development and improved quality of life. Policy makers and opinion builders from Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka will address the conference as key-note speakers.

Victim of acid throwing

Contraband worth Tk one lakh recovered

CHITTAGONG, Mar 23: A special squad of the Detective Branch of Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) in two separate raids today recovered contraband worth about Taka one lakh from different parts of the city, reports BSS. According to a CMP press release, the Special Squad on a tip-off found the contraband at Station Road and Hazari Lane. The goods included 100 pieces of Indian sarrees, 300 bottles of Phencidil and 90 bottles of Gripe Water.

Shishu Kishore Mela Bangabandhu Shishu Kishore Mela Monday appealed to Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to arrange airing of the "recorded" proclamation of independence by radio and television on the independence Day on March 26. The appeal came in a joint statement to the press of 100 members of the national children-juvenile organisation. "Who had proclaimed the independence?" said the statement referring to the debate on the issue with some people saying that Sheikh Mujibur Rahman had declared the independence and others arguing that it was Ziaur Rahman who had made the declaration. The signatories to the statement said they believed that the issue would be resolved if the proclamation was put on air by radio and television.
