World leaders greet Biswas

Heads of State and government of different countries have felicitated President Abdur Rahman Biswas on the occasion of Independence and National Day of the country, reports BSS.

In their messages, they wished the progress and prosperity of Bangladesh.

The messages have been sent by Queen Elizabeth II of England, President Corazon Aquino of the Philippines, Sultan Qabos Bin Said of Oman, Vice President Dr Branko Kostic of Yugoslavia, President Fernando Collor of Brazil, President Richard Von Weizsacker of Federal Republic of Germany, President Fidel Castro of Cuba, President Noor M Hassanali of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, President Lech Walesa of the Republic of Poland, President Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani of the Islamic Republic of Iran, President Turgot Ozal of Turkey, President Francesco Cossiga of Italy, President Ghulma Ishaq of Pakistan, President Lansa Conte of the Republic of Guinea and President Roh Tae Woo of the Republic of Korea.

The messages have also been sent by President Zaycd Bin Sultan Al Nahayyan of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Vice President Maktoum Bin Rashid Al Maktoum of the UAE.

Sponsors blasted for not raising the issue so long

'Azam's trial to be held as per law of the land'

State Minister for Communications Fashur Rahman Patal Tuesday said the issue regarding citizenship of Jamaat Chief Golam Azam and so called holding of public trial was a 'joint venture plan' against the democratic government to discredit it by creating law and order situation, reports BSS.

The State Minister said trial of Golam Azam would be held according to the law of the land and accused the sponsors of the public trial why they did not raise the issue for the last 20 years. He said 30,000 political workers were killed during 1972-75 but no question of public trial for those offenders were raised.

The State Minister was speaking at a discussion organised by the Jattiyat Abadi Samajik Sangkritik Sangstha (JASAS) in observance of 'Black Day' Tuesday at the National Museum auditorium here.

Ten years back on this day in 1982 the autocratic Ershad regime snatched away power from the elected BNP government on the alleged plea of corruption, inefficiency and law and order situation. The autocratic government ruled the country for nine years, till its downfall on December 6, 1990 through a mass movement.

Patal warned that those who wanted to create another Black Day and kill democracy they would be seriously dealt with.

Presided over by JASAS President Khurshid Ali Mollah the discussion was also addressed, among others, by the Chairman of Dhaka University Political Science Department Emajuddin Ahmed, President of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists Riaduddin Ahmed, Special Assistant to the Chairman of BNP Ehsanul Kabir, JASAS Vice President Ihtiaz Hossain Zafar, General Secretary Zahid Hossain Chunnus, DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokan and Dhaka City Jubadai.

President Abu Sayeed Khokan. Patal alleged that so long this democratic government would remain in power an identified quarter would always oppose it.

Prof Emajuddin said the Golam Azam issue should be looked as an administrative problem instead of political one and urged the government to take actions accordingly. He said such steps of the government would be backed by the people.

He suggested pulling the talents of different shades and opinions to solve the national problems and eradicate poverty and unemployment, the main enemies of democracy.

DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokan criticised both Jamaat for making Golam Azam its chief and the sponsors of public trial for passing the law and trying to create law and order situation. He urged the government to tackle the situation with a strong hand and unite the people to safeguard democracy.

BFUJ President Reazuddin Ahmed said no body should take any such step which would endanger the continuation of democracy.

Notre Dame College

The annual prize distribution ceremony and farewell '92 of Notre Dame College was held Tuesday at the college auditorium.

SCI-Bangladesh

The national executive committee of Service Civil International (SCI) Bangladesh in its meeting held on March 13 discussed the situation created by the Myanmar military junta which forced huge Rohingya exodus.

The meeting strongly condemned such inhuman atrocities, torture by Myanmar army resulting in uprooting hundreds of thousand of innocent Rohingyas from their home.

SCIBangladesh appeals to the Myanmar authorities as well as all international agencies to help the refugees and find out a permanent peaceful solution.

WHO official calls on Health Minister

The visiting Regional Director of World Health Organisation (WHO) for South East Asia Dr U Ko Ko called on Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf at his office Tuesday, reports UNB.

Aids prevention, nutrition as a multi-sectoral approach, primary health care approach which is the key to achieve 'health for all by the year 2000' and development issues of health sector in Bangladesh are discussed in the meeting.

207 detainees to be freed

The government has ordered the release of 207 detained persons after reviewing their cases under Special Powers Act of 1974 on the occasion of Independence and National Day, according to an official announcement Tuesday, reports BSS.

Malaysia may recruit more Bangladeshis

The out-going Malaysian High Commissioner to Bangladesh, Tunku Nazihah Binte Tunku Mohammad Rus, made a farewell call on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban Tuesday, reports BSS.

During the discussion, the Malaysian High Commissioner reaffirmed the President her government's total support towards meeting the Myanmar refugee problems which had created economic pressure on Bangladesh.

Tunku Nazihah informed President Biswas that different private organisations in Malaysia had started collecting funds for contributing to the Bangladesh government's efforts to help the Myanmar refugees.

Referring to the recruitment of Bangladeshis for employment in Malaysia, Tunku Nazihah assured the President that her country would consider recruiting more Bangladeshis, particularly in the on-going development projects.

She said on her going back to Malaysia she would try her best to further improve the relations between the two brotherly Muslim countries.

President Abdur Rahman Biswas thanked the Malaysian government for extending its whole-hearted support to the cause of Rohingya refugees and condemning the Myanmar government.

He said the existing bonds of friendship between Bangladesh and Malaysia was very cordial and excellent and it would be strengthened further in the years to come.

President Biswas emphasised the need for more cooperation in different sectors of economy including manpower export to Malaysia.

The President conveyed through the outgoing Malaysian High Commissioner his best wishes to the Malaysian King and the Prime Minister and wished good health and happiness of them and the people of Malaysia.

IOM to provide health facilities to Rohingyas

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) will provide transport and health facilities to the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh, reports BSS.

This was informed by a three-member high level IOM team in a meeting with the Additional Secretary in-charge of the Relief Ministry M A Hakim held here Tuesday.

They discussed in details about the helping of the Rohingyas.


