## Attack on newspaper offices condemned

A joint meeting of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) Saturday condemned armed attack on the offices of daily Inqilab, daily Sangbad, daily Al-Ameen, daily Sangram, daily Meillat, daily Bhor and Chittagong Press Club during

last few days, reports BSS. The speakers at the meeting, presided over by BFUJ President Reazuddin Ahmed, observed that the hard-earned democracy and freedom of the press cannot remain hostage at the hands of some indiscreet quarters.

The speakers cautioned that the journalists would resist the identified terrorists if good sense did not prevail upon them.
