## 'No nation can prosper without increasing literacy rate'

President Abdur Rahman Biswas Sunday gave a fervent call to all concerned quarters to free the campus from terrorism, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at a discussion on "the ways of freeing the country from illiteracy and campus terrorism" in Dhaka in the afternoon, President Biswas appealed to all sections of people to take a determined move in this re-

He said without increasing the rate of literacy no country could become strong and prosperous, and for that reason, the President pleaded, there has to be a concerted national will to combat campus terrorism for restoring congenial academic atmosphere.

Organised by the "Bangladesh Shakkharata Samity," the discussion was presided over by its President Dr Khandaker Bazlul Hug.

Deputy Leader of the Jatiya Sangsad Dr A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury and State Minister for Education Principal Mohammad Yunus spoke as the special guests.

The former Education Secretary and Adviser to the acting President, Kazi Fazlur Rahman, former Vice- Chancellor of the Dhaka University and currently the Chairman of the University Grants Commission Prof Shamsul Huq, Vice-Chancellor of Jahangir Nagar University Dr Kazi Saleh Ahmed, Prof Osman Gant and Abdur Rob Chowdhury MP took part in the discussions.

Prof Badruddoza Chowdhury said that the campus terrorism, which has been the much talked about issue in the society, could not be removed only through administrative mea-

He said the terrorism or the violence on the campus was not only related with politics, but also many other factors were involved in it.

He said it would be unfair only to blame the students for campus terrorism when the menace has already affected the other parts of the society.

Prof Chowdhury pointed out that terrorism in the campus was related with various "socio-political aspects" as the students were being used by


