Saudi people donate 688 tents for Rohingyas

Saudi people have donated 688 tents for the Rohingya Muslim refugees which reached in Dhaka Monday night, reports UNB.

These tents, weighing about 41 metric tons, were airlifted by the Zia International Airport by a Saudi special cargo plane.

Additional Secretary in charge of the Ministry of Relief MA Hakim received the consignment from Saudi Charge d'Affaires to Bangladesh Talaat Hamza Shera at the airport last night.

These relief supplies were sent by the Saudi people responding to an appeal by King Fahd Bin Abdul Aziz over television to the nation for helping the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh.

Earlier, they sent 40 metric tons of food stuff, and more relief will be coming in phases.

Kuwait returnees give ultimatum to govt

The leaders of Kuwait repatriated Bangladeshis at a press conference Tuesday put an ultimatum to realise the compensation forms from the Ministry of Labour and Manpower by April 15.

Denouncing the delay, they said, if the government failed to distribute the forms by that time, the Bangladeshis repatriated from Kuwait would go for a greater movement.

The movement programmes include processions and submission of memorandum to administration at upazila level, submission of memorandum to the Speaker during the coming session of Jatiya Sangsad, rally and hunger-processions in Dhaka.

Earlier, United Nations Compensation Commission decided to compensate every migrant labourer who were forced to leave Kuwait in the wake of Iraqi invasion of Kuwait in August, 1990.

Later the commission sent the 'claim forms' to the Bangladesh government last December but the government is yet to distribute the forms.

On the government's recent decision to open a cell for the Kuwait repatriated Bangladeshis, the President of the association, Ali Ashraf Khan, said that they would not accept the decision until two of their representatives were included in the committee of the cell.

The press conference held at the Jatiya Press Club was also addressed by the association's Secretary General, Nur Mohammad Siddiq.

36 detenus released

The government has ordered release of 36 detenus after reviewing their cases under the Special Powers Act 1974 on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr, reports UNB.

The release orders came after consideration of their long detention, submission of chargesheet of specific case, final chargesheet on civil suit brought about detention order for light offence, acquittal from case and others.

The government hoped that the released people would play due role in the socio-economic development of the country as bonafide citizens.

Literacy rate falls after '75, says Hasina

Awami League President Sheikh Hasina Tuesday called for pragmatic steps by the government to increase literacy rate in the country by spreading female education, reports UNB.

Speaking at a reception at Cox's Bazar Women's College, she said there had been no progress in the education sector in last 20 years for lack of proper planning. Rather, the literacy rate had declined in post-75 era.

Hasina, Leader of the Opposition in Parliament, said the country cannot have real development by leaving the vast section of womenfolk unlettered.

She called for creating a favourable atmosphere so that women could be educated and become economically self-reliant.

The Awami League chief criticised the government for rejecting an opposition resolution in last session of parliament that sought to set up primary school in every village of the country.

She listed various measures of the Awami League government for development of the education sector neglected over the years. The Bangladesh government had set up 11,000 primary schools and made education compulsory upto class eight, Hasina added.

Principal Osman Sarwar Alam Chowdhury presided over the function.
