Speakers at a discussion meeting Wednesday lauded the glorious role played by late Lt Commander Moazzem Hossain in the country's War of Liberation.

The meeting was arranged by 'Amra Muktiyuddher Santan' (We the Children of the Sanghati Parishad in observance of the death anniversary of late Moazzem who was the second accused in the historic Agartala Conspiracy Case.

Chairman of the Muktiyuddha Sanghati Parishad and an accused in the Agartala Conspiracy Case Col (ret'd) Shawqat Ali, MP, another accused in the case Sultanuddin Ahmed, former General Secretary of the Jahangirnagar University Teachers' Association, Dr Alauddin Ahmed and General Secretary of the Amra Muktiyuddhar Santan Abu Sayed al Mahmud addressed the meeting.

Ehsanul Amin, President of the organisation, was in the chair.

Col (ret'd) Shawqat Ali in his speech said that Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib led the process to liberate the country politically while the military leadership in that process was given by Lt Commander Moazzem.

But his contribution was not known to the new generation, Shawqat regretted.

Sultanuddin Ahmed observed the contribution of the architects of the country's independence and the freedom fighters was thrown away from the history.

Dr Alauddin Ahmed called for conducting research on the life of Moazzem.

'Show respect to people's verdict'

The Presidium of Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) resolved on Wednesday that the government must show respect to the people's desire manifested through the public trial of Golan Azam on March 26.

The CPB Presidium also resolved that the government should immediately come forward with effective steps for the restoration of political stability of the country which had been threatened by the provocations of the reactionary forces following the public trial of Golan Azam.

The Presidium, in a press release issued to the press yesterday said government should take stern steps against those trying to create conflicting situation in the political arena by means of publishing list of so-called collaborators of India.

In this connection the CPB presidium also felt for unity among the patriotic democratic forces of the country.

In another resolution, CPB press release said, the presidium condemned attack on the newspapers, newsmen and the press club for the sake of freedom of press.

The CPB Presidium has also condemned the government for registering cases against '24 personalities including Jahannara Imam' on charge of subversive activities.

CPB has demanded of the government to immediately withdraw the cases.

One 'terror' of DU held

The Detective Branch of Dhaka Metropolitan police arrested a 'terror' of Dhaka University, Enamul Haq Abeer, from the Plassey crossing Tuesday night, reports UNB.

Abeer (22), a resident of Jastmuddin Hall, was picked up by a special squad of DB at 11:30 pm on charge of his involvement in terrorist activity, including extortion and gun-battle, in the campus and its adjoining areas.

Police said Abeer along with 'other terrorists' set fire to a vehicle and opened fire on police in the University area after the arrest of 'another terrorist', Tokon.

Manzurul Alam Tokon, VP of Zahurul Haq Hall and a leader of Chhatra League (A-A), was arrested in a police raid on the hall on March 29.

Eid-ul-Fitr programmes

Eid-ul-Fitr, the greatest Muslim festival will be celebrated in Bangladesh with due religious fervour and festivity, tentatively on April 5, subject to the sighting of the Shawwal Moon the previous evening, reports BSS.

If the moon is not sighted on April 4, Eid will be celebrated on April 6.

The government has declared the Eid holidays from April 4 to 6.

According to Islamic Foundation, the main Eid Congregation will be held at the National Eidgah at 7.30 am on the Eid day. However, the venue will be shifted to Baitul Mukarram National Mosque, if the weather becomes inclement on the day, and the congregation at the mosque will be held at 8 am.

The government has made elaborate arrangements to celebrate the festival.

The road running from the Old Airport to Bangabhaban will be decorated with national flags and banners inscribed with Eid Mubarak message both in Bangla and Arabic. The road islands throughout the route will be decorated with miniature flags and bunting.

Radio Bangladesh and Bangladesh Television will broadcast and telecast special programmes befitting the day. The national dailies will appear with special Eid day supplement.

Inmates in jails, hospitals, children-homes and vagrants homes will be served with improved food on the Eid day.

The President, the Prime Minister and the Leader of the Opposition will give Eid day message to the nation.

Football games and Eid reunion of children in the city would be arranged after holy Eid.

The Deputy Commissioners will organise Eid congregation in their districts in accordance with the national programmes. Bangladesh missions abroad will also chalkout similar programmes to observe the day in a befitting manner.

Meanwhile, different mosques in the city have announced the Eid prayer timings.

Eid prayer at the Dhaka University Central Mosque will be held at 8 am and 9.30 pm. The prayer at Shahidullah Hall Mosque and at Zahurul Huq Hall Mosque will be held at 8 a.m and 7.30 a.m respectively. Lalimata Shahi Mosque had arranged Eid prayer at 8 in the morning.

The prayer at the Alta Madrasah Mosque will be held at 8.30 am. The Noorani Jame Mosque and Oliganj Haqqani Mosque opposite to Saderghat terminal will hold the Eid prayer at the same time.

In order to facilitate the passengers to celebrate the Eid at their homes outside Dhaka, the Bangladesh Railway and Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporations have arranged additional trains and water-way services from the capital to different destinations.
