## 35 tonnes more Saudi relief goods for Rohingyas

A special Saudi cargo aircraft carrying about 35 metric tons of relief materials for the Rohingya refugees taking shelter in Bangladesh arrived Monday at the Zia International Airport, according to an official handout, reports BSS.

The relief goods included 1,650 packets of food items containing 10 kg of rice, 5 kg of sugar, 3 kg of edible oil and 2 kg of powdered milk in each packet.

The Additional Secretary in charge of the Ministry of Relief, M A Hakim, received the relief materials on behalf of the government of Bangladesh from the Saudi Charge d'Affaires, Talat Hamza Sherha, at the airport.

The Saudi government has

so far donated 5,025 packets of food items and 1,236 pieces of tents for the Rohingya refugees taking shelter in Bangladesh.

The Saudi Charge d'Affaires said that more relief materials would be sent for the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh soon.

## Manik Mia's daughter dead

Elders daughter of Tafazzal Hossain Manik Mia and one of the directors of Dainik Ittefaq Begum Akhtarunnahar Baby died Monday at 4 pm at the PG hospital, says a press release.

She was admitted into the hospital on March 25 as she was suffering from liver cirrhosis. She left behind two sons and one daughter. Her husband Professor Md Yunus Mia died in 1985.

She was buried Monday night at the premises of Narinda Sha Saheb's Mazaar beside her husband's grave.

## Three alleged criminals held in city

Police arrested three alleged criminals from Purana Paltan area on charge of ransacking, looting and beating up the employees of two shops including a pharmacy in the area Monday, reports BSS.

According to Motijheel police sources, a gang of miscreants led by one Abul Kalam suddenly attacked the shops on Monday afternoon. They broke the showcase of Hossain Pharmacy and severely injured one employee of the pharmacy with a sharp knife, the sources said.

The injured employee, identified as Nurul Amin, was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital for treatment.

As the shopkeepers made hue and cry, people from around came to their rescue and the miscreants tried to flee.

But local people in cooperation with the police on duty managed to arrest one of the criminals identified as Munir Hossain.

Police arrested two more persons Tuesday on the basis of the confessional statement of Munir. Tuesday's arrested persons were identified as Shah Alam and Qudus.

Meanwhile, the Purana Paltan Businessmen Welfare Association expressed its concern over the incident.
