Awami League Joint Secretary Abdul Jalil Monday said the BNP's role on the question of Golam Azam again proved it wants to stay in power with the support of anti-liberation Jamaat-e-Islami, reports UNB.  
Addressing an extended meeting of Narayanganj District Awami League, Jalil demanded implementation of the "people's court" verdict against Golam Azam.

**10.5 pc people suffer from iodine deficiency**  
Ten point five zero per cent people of Bangladesh are suffering from various diseases following iodine deficiency, BSCIC source said in the city Monday, quoting a survey report, says BSS.  
The diseases due to iodine deficiency are very much common in the districts of Rangpur, Dinajpur, Mymensingh, Jamalpur, Bogra, Dhaka, Chittagong and Hill Tracts.  
To eradicate such diseases, UNICEF and Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation (BSCIC) have taken up a programme to supply iodine mixture machines and potassium iodide to 210 salt mills in the country for mixing iodine with salt.  
Thirty such iodine mixture machines will be installed by the current fiscal year and more 50 machines will be made available to the salt industries soon.  
In the meantime, the UNICEF have given lipidol (iodine supplement) injection to six lakh people of the country.
