Govt urged to open dialogue on Azam issue

Muktijoddha Sangram Parishad Thursday urged the government to open dialogue with the opposition political parties in the parliament and the forums of freedom fighters with a view to reaching a consensus on the Golam Azam issue.

In a statement issued last night, the parishad opined that the country's independence, sovereignty, democracy and political stability would be endangered if the 'conspiracy' being hatched against the freedom fighters and the spirit of the Liberation War centering the Golam Azam issue was not foiled.

Both the ruling and the opposition parties would have to bear equally the consequences arising out of the issue, the statement warned.

Issued by the parishad Chairman A K M Enayetullah and General Secretary Manzurul Haque Sikdar, the statement expressed grave concern over the Jatiya Sangsad's role in dealing with the Golam Azam issue.

It also stressed the need for a political step parallel to legal action against the war criminal Golam Azam and said people expect the present parliament would carry out responsibilities properly.

None is above law: Rafique

Works Minister Rafique Islam Mia said Thursday the present democratic government was committed to establish the rule of law in the country, reports BSS.

He said that none was above law and trial of Golam Azam would be held under the existing law of the country.

The Minister was speaking as the chief guest at the Biennial Conference of the Munshiganj City Unit of Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Thursday.

The minister said that the present government was elected by the people to ensure people's welfare and the government was fulfilling its commitments made by the party during the last elections.

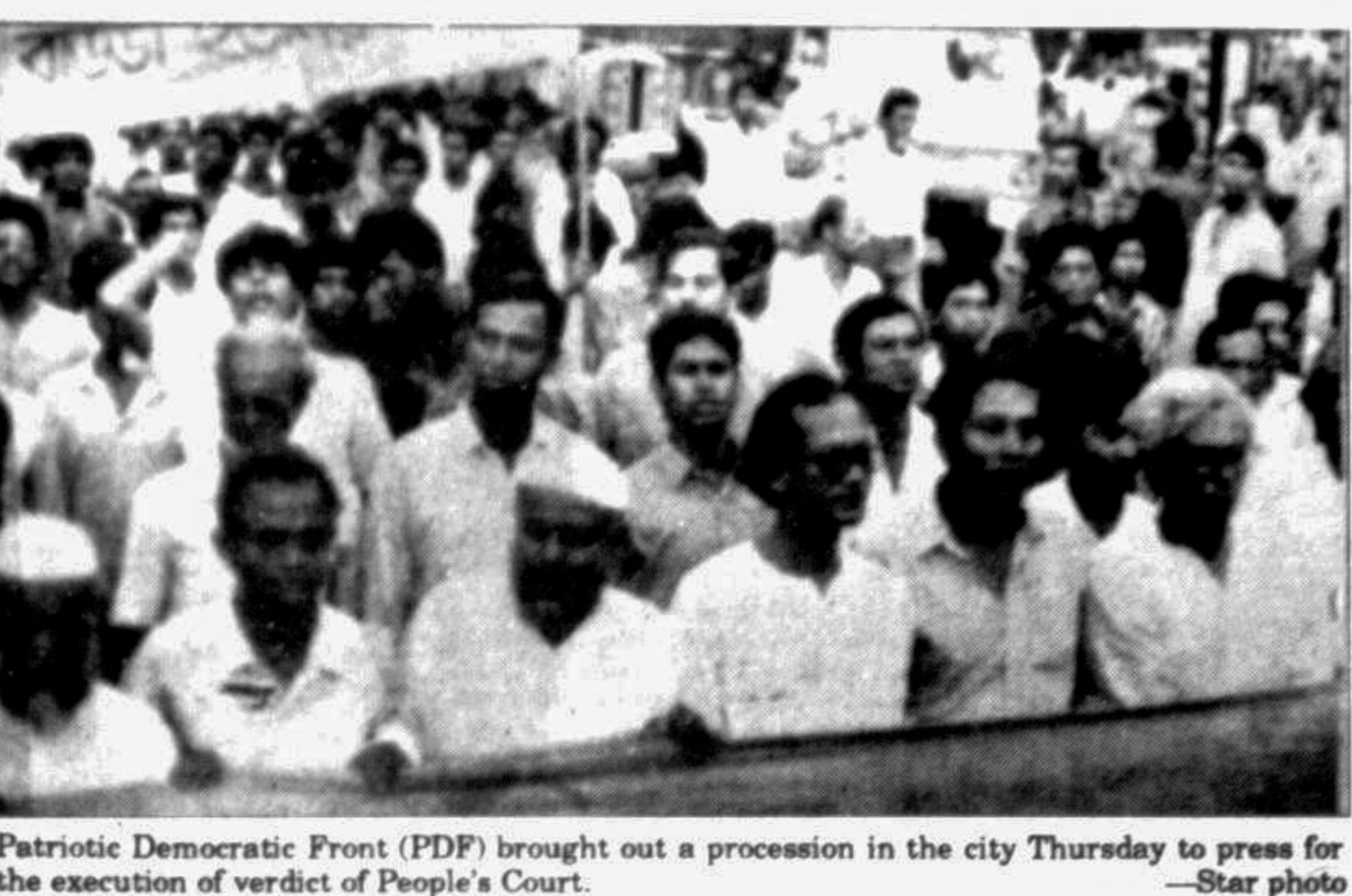
Role of women in uplift lauded

BNP tarnishing image of Liberation War: PDF

Patriotic Democratic Front (PDF) Thursday said the BNP government had compromised with the Jamaat to stay in power and had tarnished the image of the Liberation War as well as democracy by avoiding the public demand to try Golam Azam.

In a rally organised by the PDF in front of the Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) office at Purana Paltan, leaders denounced Prime Minister Khaleda Zia's statements made against the opposition parties recently in various BNP rallies.

Presided over by PDF leader Dilip Barua the rally was addressed among others by CPB leader Nurul Islam Nahid, Gana Azadi League leader Al Haj Abdus Samad, National Awami Party leader Pankaj Bhattacharya.

Pankaj Bhattacharya alleged that by calling for a movement against the opposition at the BNP rally in the city on April 20, Begum Zia was launching a movement for the Jamaat.

Highlighting the country's present economic and drought problems the NAP leaders urged the government to solve those problems.

The leader also called upon the government to find out a political solution to the problems of Chittagong Hill Tracts and give the hill tracts people all rights a citizen should deserve.

Nurul Islam Nahid told the audience that the government which claims to be democratic must prove that it is on people's side through implementing the wish of majority and added the majority wants the execution of People's Court verdict.

Leaders in the rally echoed that BNP had begun to walk away from the people and had started sounding like an autocrat.

Presided over by A K A Firoz Noon, the seminar was addressed, among others, by State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof Jahanara Begum as the chief guest, playwright Askar Ibne Shaik, poet Al Mahmud, poet Al Mujahid, drama-artist Dilara Zaman, journalist Khandaker Hasnat Karim, noted drama-artist Ariful Haq presented a keynote paper at the seminar.

The speakers said we achieved independence through struggle and now we should consolidate it by acquiring excellence in all fields of knowledge including science, literature, art and culture.

Prof Jahanara, gave a brief resume of the glorious tradition of Bangladesh culture and urged the cultural activists to come forward to revitalise our own culture through its effective exercise.

Ariful Haq, in his paper, said drama does not now reflect society, rather it has become a weapon of achieving a particular political motive.
