### \$ 1.881m IDB grant for Rohingyas

The Islamic Development Bank (IDB) has approved a grant of 1.881 million dollars for Myanmar Muslim refugees in Bangladesh, official sources said here Saturday, reports

The approval was given at a meeting of the Board of Executive Directors of the bank held on April 21.

The grant will be utilised for the construction of camps for the refugees and for providing other urgent facilities such as tubewells, trench latrines and mobile medical services trucks.

Besides, the IDB had contacted a number of relief organisations and other interested organisations in Saudi Arabia such as Islamic International Relief Agency. Jeddah and Rabeta Al-Alam Al Islami Makka Al Mokarram to mobilise more help for the refugees. The bank will coordinate with these organisations and cooperate with them to maximise the help for the Myanmar Muslim refugees in Bangladesh.

# 90 pc rural children anaemic, 30,000 become blind a year

Prof A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury Sunday underscored the need for dedication by the educated people work ing with the government as well as the NGOs to overcome the problems faced by the children, reports BSS.

He said the people should be given the proper knowledge of health and nutrition so that they could provide necessary care and nutrition to the children with the limited resources available to them.

Prof Chowdhury, the Deputy Leader of the Jatiya Sangsad, was speaking as the chief guest at a seminar on "We Are For the Children" organised by the Rotaract Club of Sir Salimullah Medical College (SSMC) on behalf of Rotaract District 3280 at the Prof Ibrahim Diabetic Hospital Auditorium in the city.

He said 90 per cent rural children were anaemic and 30,000 children were getting blind each year for want of fron and vitamin respectively. But our 'Lal Shak, Kachu Shak and Data Shak' have plenty of iron and vitamin and could meet the needs of the children.

He said gur (molasses) had all the qualities as sugar. But in addition it had calcium and tron which are not found in sugar. 'Gur syrup' is better than sugar syrup and good for

stomach and health, he added The seminar was also ad dressed, among others, by Governor of Rotarian District 3280 Prof Jalal U Ahmed, head of Surgery Department of SSMC Prof M A Majid, Prof of Medicine of SSMC Ferdous Ara Jahan, head of Paediatrics of SSMC Prof F II Nazir, Chairman of District Rotaract committee Kaiser Ahmed and Rotaract Selim Sazzad Huq.

Prof Badruddoza said beans had 30 per cent protein content but green beans used as vegetables had almost no protein. But the people were consuming green beans mainly for lack of knowledge and educa

Referring to stoppage of child labour, he said strong political will was needed to do

He said the children should be given life oriented education so that they could sustain it. He also said that the children should be taught social

values and the females should be given priority in all sorts of education.

Prof Jalal Ahmed said Rotary Club was working to eradicate polio from the world by the year 2000. And it has donated polio vaccines worth Taka 30 crore to Bangladesh through the UNICEF. Now they are concentrating on func tional literacy where within four months one could learn the three R's.

Prof Majid said those, who could afford to feed more children, were following the principle of planned parenthood But the poor were not following that principle. They should be motivated in this direction through creation of awareness,

Prof Ferdous Ara suggested to be vocal against child labour and repression on children She said congenial atmosphere was needed for physical and mental growth of a child.

Prof F H Nazir said 65 per cent of the child diseases could be prevented if the knowledge of health, nutrition and sanitation could be applied. Illiteracy is the main obstacle to it, he added.


