**Italian aid monitoring office opens**

Italy has opened a new Aid and Development Cooperation office at Port City of Chittagong, a press release issued by Italian embassy said Tuesday, reports BSS.

Italian Ambassador Claudio Facilio inaugurated the office on April 13, which will coordinate and monitor activities of various projects funded by the Italian government to improve the areas which are frequently devastated by natural calamities.

Bangladesh and Italy signed a political agreement in Rome two months ago and a mechanism of cooperation has already been established in the field of infrastructure development and technical assistance in health and agriculture sector.

A development linked disaster preparedness and response programme is at the early stage of implementation in view of the recurrence of cyclone and floods in Chittagong district.

This project has been visualised with the intention to develop a system for disaster management by intention to develop a system for disaster management by involving the vulnerable community, local NGOs and officials.

**Aquarium Society formed**

A new organisation titled 'Bangladesh Aquarium Society' was formed in Dhaka Monday at a meeting of the aquarium fish culturists, concerned traders and the organisers of the first aquarium (Bahari) fish exhibition, according to a press release, reports BSS.

The meeting elected a 22-member ad-hoc committee of the Society. The president of Bangladesh Zoological Society and the Chairman of Dhaka University Zoology Department Prof Dr M Shahadat Ali was elected Chairman of the ad-hoc committee.

M Farooq and Dr Shahidul Alam Khan were elected Vice-Presidents and the President of Bangladesh Pet Animal Traders Association, Shaiful Islam Talukder was Elected General Secretary.

**Govt move to enhance ferry fare protested**

Bangladesh Sarak Paribahan Samity BPS Monday protested the government's 'unilateral' decision to enhance the ferry fare by 30 per cent, reports UNB.

Leaders of the Samity in a statement termed as 'baseless and imaginary' the government claim that it had reached an understanding with the transport owners association in this regard.

The statement said the government had rather assumed the transport owners' association that its reasonable demands, including reduction of oil price and ferry fare, would be met through discussion from next July.

The Samity leaders demanded of the government to stall the decision or face the consequences.

**A sufferer's protest**

On Saturday, April 25 I along with three of my colleagues set out from Dhaka for Chittagong by car. We left Dhaka at 3.30 pm and reached Gorarganj near Mirer Shoraj at about 8.30 pm Chittagong City is about one and a half hour from this point. We could not go any further as the Dhaka-Chittagong Highway was blocked by feuding students of Nizampur College near Gorarganj.

We saw a line, stretching over a few miles, of passenger buses and trucks loaded with goods queued up on the highway unable to move towards Chittagong due to the blockade. According to the stranded passengers and truck drivers most of them were waiting on the highway from 12 noon with no hope in sight of reaching their destination.

We saw bus-loads of passengers including infants, minors and women suffering on the road from heat, humidity and dust. Very little food and drinking water was available to them. They had already travelled over six hours before reaching Gorarganj and were stranded on the road for nearly nine hours when we saw them. We also saw hundreds of people, men, women and children coming from Chittagong on foot as they had to abandon their vehicles on the other side of Nizampur College.

According to these people, there was very little hope of an early solution to the problem. They narrated a tale of woes since the time the students began to block the road. According to them the JCD and BCL activists of the college fought each other in which fire arms were freely used and then began to attack private cars and buses on the highway. Many passengers were also beaten up. Wind shields were broken, tyres flattened, car keys pinched and drivers were chased away. The road was immediately blocked by deserted cars and buses. There was complete panic in the area. People coming from Chittagong also narrated how a medicine shop belonging to a political activist was ransacked during the battle terrorising other shop owners in the market.

While we were waiting on the highway we saw a just-married couple arrive at the spot by car from Dhaka. The bride, still in her bridal attire, was completely terrified not expecting such a reception on the wedding night. Concerned about their security the couple drove off somewhere in the dark desperately looking for a safe shelter.

The Dhaka-Chittagong trunk road is the only road link between the capital and the port-city. This link is often completely cut off by agitating students, workers and bus/truck drivers on flimsiest pretext. The law enforcing agencies as usual take their own time to act. Everytime this happens, the human miseries and sufferings described here are replayed.

This time the sufferings were compounded as train link between Chittagong and Dhaka was also cut off due to the derailling of the Paharika Express earlier on the day near Sitakunda.
