40 GIS software computers developed to meet needs

A local company has developed a computer software named GIS 'Geographical Information System' in which the whole of Bangladesh upto mouza level has been programmed in the form of maps, reports BSS.

Demonstrating a prototype of the GIS to the press at the Jatiya Press Club here Tuesday, Managing Director of the company Ghulam Mohiuddin said even a remote village could be identified within seconds with all relevant information popping up on maps or on screen for the user.

He said the information could come both in Bengali and English and could be helpful for the decision makers. Besides utilising still images and maps, GIS is also capable of presenting information through sound as well as video (audio-visual presentation), he said.

He also said that basic data

on population, area, geocode and households received from the Bureau of Statistics were but into the GIS. Rest of the data could be fed in to the GIS as required, he said.

Mohiuddin said his company Citech Limited had engaged 20 programmers, under the leadership of programmer Waqar Adel, who worked for six months in two shifts to complete the huge task.

Adel, a young man with a one-year diploma in computer science from the United States, said they had developed about 40 software packages so far to meet the requirements of the local users.

In reply to a question regarding entering into international software and data market, Mohiuddin said increase in the number of local users and development of local software packages were the primary requirements to attract foreign customers. This

needed government patronisation, he added.

He said the first version of GIS was created after the April 1991 cyclone to monitor the relief effort in the thirty-six worst-hit upazilas and used at the relief co-ordinator's office at Chittagong.

BAU exams from May 4

Legal step against C R Datta demanded

Leaders of Zia Gabeshana Kendra Tuesday demanded legal action against C R Datta, President of Hindu, Bouddha and Christian Oikya Parishad and others for their 'insolent' statement, reports BSS.

Expressing concern at such statement, the leaders of the Kendra said Datta and others of the Oikya Parishad had given anti-state statements to provide communalism in the country.

Datta had given this 'conspiratorial' statement taking advantage of the freedom of speech in the country to destroy the existing communal

harmony, tarnish the image of the present democratic government and destabilise it, and put sovereignty at stake. Criticizing the silence of the Awami League and Five-Party on Datta's Statement, the leaders of the Zia Gabeshana Kendra said there is no place of the majority Muslim population in the Oikya Parishad though the Muslims of Bangladesh had always discarded communalism.

The people of this country never accepted communalism, Brahmanism and racism for centuries and about one crore Hindus are living here with the Muslims, Bouddhas and Christians, they said.

Akbar Imam, Joint Convener of Zia Gabeshana Kendra, M Tarikulah, Member-Secretary, and Masudur Rahman Siddiqui, Office Secretary signed the statement.

Dhaka laboratories of Bangladesh Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (BCSIR) organised a Eid reunion function at the auditorium of the council Tuesday noon. Chairman of BCSIR Dr M Waliuzzaman was the chief guest at the function while Dr Sufura Nurunnabi, Director of BCSIR labs presided.

JCD
Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leaders Tuesday at a rally on the Dhaka University campus said a certain quarter had been working on against the present government to destroy democracy.

They said violence in the campus was a part of their conspiracy. The rally and procession was addressed by JCD leader Habib-un-Nabi Sohel and Ali Abbas Nadim. The leaders also denounced the attack made recently on the residence of the Vice Chancellor and on the Provost of Zahurul Haq Hall.

NAP
Bangladesh National Awami Party Tuesday protested the government's decision to shut down the Fenchuganj Fertilizer Factory and demanded mod-

ernisation of the factory in order to make it profitable. NAP President Prof Mozaffar Ahmed and General Secretary Sree Pankaj Bhattacharya in a joint statement said shut down of the factory would bring misery to hundreds of labourers.

National Assoc of Journalists

Bangladesh National Association of Journalists President M R Mahub and Secretary General Professor Md Shekh Sadi Tuesday expressed their grave concern and resentment over the attack made on six journalists of Khulna and on the Khulna Press Club. The journalist leaders demanded punitive measures against the assailants immediately.

JSD (Rab)
Jatiya Samjtantrik Dal (JSD-Rab) Tuesday in a public meeting demanded immediate release of JSD leader ASM Abdur Rab and called for a half day strike on May 18 in the city to press home their demand to form special tribunal for Golam Azam.

The rally was addressed by Nur Alam Jiku, Professor Humayun Kabir Hiru, Syed Zafar Sazzad, Abdul Maiek Ratan and others.

IJO recommends four projects

The Committee on Projects of International Jute Organisation (IJO) will undertake an environment impact assessment of jute and jute products in order to capture global markets, reports UNB.

This was decided at the IJO's 17th session which concluded in Dhaka Tuesday. It was chaired by Francus Walter from France.

About 90 delegates from members and observer countries including FAO, UTC and UNDP attended the session.

The session reviewed the ongoing projects and recommended four projects for consideration of the International Jute Council (IJC), the highest body of the IJO.

The projects are: Preparation of a comparative environmental impact assessment for jute and polypropylene fibres and products, pilot scale production of enzymes for improvement of low grade jute and cuttings, reformulated market promotion project for jute carpet backing in the United States and interim market development programme in selected European countries.

Canada based International Development Centre has shown interest to consider funding of the pilot scale production of enzymes for improvement of low grade jute and cuttings project.

Regarding market promotion in the USA, the session was told that a consultant has been appointed to evaluate trends in USA jute market.

Khaled Rab of Bangladesh has been elected Chairman for 1992-93 while Sami-ul-Huq Khilji of Pakistan has been elected Vice Chairman.
