

40 cyclone shelters near completion

Work on 40 cyclone shelters in the coastal areas of the country is nearing completion while 100 others progressing fast under the Disaster Preparedness Programme of the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS), reports UNB.

This was stated by BDRCS Chairman Syed Shahidul Haq Jamal, MP, while giving a resume of the progress of work under the Disaster Preparedness Programme in Dhaka Wednesday.

These cyclone shelters will add to the existing 62 such centres in different parts of the coastal districts, said a BDRCS press release.

Scientists, technologists urged to introduce modern technology

KHULNA, Apr 29: Speaker of Jatiya Sangsad Shaikh Razaque Ali today called upon the scientists and technologists to play a pioneering role in the introduction of modern technology in our day-to-day life for bringing about overall development of the country, reports BSS.

He was inaugurating a seminar on "Use and Expansion of locally innovated technology" at local Sports Association's gymnasium.

Jointly sponsored by the science and technology department of the government and the Khulna District Administration, the seminar was presided over by Dilip Kumar Biswas, outgoing Additional Divisional Commissioner In-Charge, Khulna, and addressed by Dr Ashraf Siddiqui, Chairman BSS Board of Directors, Dr Golam Rahman, Vice Chancellor, Khulna University, Begum Khodeza Azam, Joint Secretary and Adviser of Science and Technology, Ministry of Education and Abdul Moktadir Choudhury, Divisional Commissioner, Khulna.

The one-day seminar was participated by the Deputy Commissioners, UNOs and concerned officials of greater Khulna.

The speaker said that the use of modern science and technology in every sphere of our activities would help us achieve the desired national goal of self-sufficiency. Aquarium fish show concludes

The five-day aquarium (Bahari) fish exhibition held at the special exhibition room of the National Museum concluded Wednesday in the midst of great enthusiasm among the visitors, reports BSS.

Over 1.5 lakh people mostly children and women visited the exhibition in which around 1000 fish of different local and imported species were on display, the organisers said.

Bangladesh Zoological Society, Dhaka University Zoology Department and the National Museum jointly organised the exhibition.

Maintain ecological balance: President

President Abdur Rahman Biswas called for maintaining ecological balance with cooperation of all sections of the society for protecting the country from catastrophic natural disasters, reports BSS.

In a message recalling the greatest cyclone and tidal surge of April 29, 1991, President Biswas said Bangladesh had been facing such disasters because of imbalance in ecology. He also sought help and cooperation of the friendly countries for striving a climatic balance.

He prayed for the peace of the lost souls in the centuries greatest calamity which hit almost the entire coastline of the country, and expressed his heartfelt sympathy for the members of the bereaved families.

He said the present democratic government had faced the aftermath of the calamity with utmost efficiency, pragmatism and courage. The lives of innumerable people were saved and their rehabilitation arranged only due to massive relief and rehabilitation operation by the movement, he said.

Brunei donates Tk 1.08 cr for cyclone-hit people

The Brunei Darussalam High Commissioner to Bangladesh Pengiran Haji Jaya, Wednesday called on the Foreign Minister A S M Mostafizur Rahman, at the latter's office in Dhaka, reports BSS.

During the meeting the High Commissioner handed over to the Foreign Minister a cheque for Taka one crore eight lakh for the rehabilitation of the people affected by the devastating cyclonic storm and tidal surge that hit the country's coastal belt on April 29 last year.

The Foreign Minister appreciated the gesture shown by Brunei Darussalam to help the cyclone-hit people of Bangladesh. They also discussed matters of bilateral interest.

Mostafizur Rahman told the envoy that Bangladesh was now in a position to supply both skilled and unskilled manpower to Brunei.
