Garments Assoc seeks govt steps to end deadlock
Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association Thursday sought government intervention to resolve the stalemate in shipment of goods at the Chittagong port because of strike, reports UNB.
The association urged the government to take steps immediately to end the deadlock.
The association as a statement Thursday said export and import of garments were greatly hampered owing to the strike of dock workers over the last one week.
Shipment of garments is being delayed, which might lead to cancellation of export orders, it apprehended.
The strike will inflict loss not only on the industry, which fetches lion's share of foreign exchange, but also deprive the country of earning a large quantum of foreign currency.

Abdullah Al-Noman presided over the meeting.
The meeting reviewed the progress of various on-going projects of fisheries and livestock and stressed the need of their completion in time.
Members of Parliament Messers Dipankar Talukder, Gazi Aziz Ferdous, Begum Lutfunnesa Hossain, Begum Bani Ashraf, Shaik Haroon Rashid Mia, Shahjahan Khan, Maksud ibne Aziz (Lama), Shajsh Chandra Roy, Md Abdus Salam Pintoo and Additional Secretary-in-charge of the Ministry of Environment and Forest Abdur Rashid were present in the meetings.

The meeting observed that fisheries and livestock are the two sectors that can provide self-employment to both educated and uneducated people and thus can do a great deal to minimise unemployment problem in the country.

The meeting discussed various matters relating to strengthening the upazila plantation and nursery project and emphasised on its success by eliminating the reasons of its failure in the past.
The problems arising out of cutting trees from the tea gardens of Sylhet along with setting up of some tourism centre in the Sundarbans also came up in the discussion.
