## Influx of Rohingyas continues

Influx of Rohingyas Muslims into Bangladesh continues at an alarming rate despite bilateral agreements on repatriation of the Myanmar refugees, reports UNB.

According to official counts, more than 11 thousand refugees have crossed into the country since the agreements were reached in Dhaka last week, swelling to 234,371 the total number of refugees.

About 2,000 refugees on an average are crossing the Naf river everyday.

## BHRC

Justice KM Sobhan, Chairman of the Bangladesh Human Rights Commission, in a statement Sunday expressed his deep concern on the press report that two minor girls - Anwara (15) and Sharifa (16) - were now facing trial in a Pakistani court for prostitution under the Islamic Huhud Law which is punishable by stoning the accused to death.

In his statement Justice Sobhan alleged that the Bangladesh government had failed to stop women trafficking from Bangladesh and demanded that the Bangladesh government intervene in this grave matters immediately and take necessary action for repatriation of the two girls from Pakistan.

## Ganatantri Party

## Jamaat, Shibir create reign of terror, alleges NAP

The National Awami Party (NAP) alleged yesterday that the anti-liberation Jamaat-Shibir forces had created a reign of terror at Joypurhat town under the direct patronisation of the local administration.

The Jamaat-Shibir activists had filed false cases against 13 political workers of the pro-liberation parties including the NAP and Ganatantri Party, the NAP President Prof Mozaffar Ahmed and its General Secretary Pankaj Bhattacharya said in a statement.

The NAP leaders also alleged that false cases were filed against 24 anti-Jamaat political workers including Ismail Hossain and Shafiqur Rahman of Chhatra Samity in Khulna.
