**Uplift projects worth Tk 14.50 cr undertaken**

The government has undertaken four development projects at a cost of Taka 14 and a half crore including a foreign exchange component of Taka 6 crore 20 lakh for preservation, renovation and improvement of archaeological relics. These projects will be implemented under the Fourth Five-Year Plan period, reports BSS.

This was disclosed at the fourth Parliamentary Standing Committee meeting on Cultural Affairs Ministry held at the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban Tuesday. State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof Jahannara Begum presided.

The meeting was informed that the second phase preservation work of Paharpur and Bagerhat archaeology is being implemented at a cost of Taka 5 crore 99 lakh.

Renovation and excavation of 26 archaeological sites has been taken up. Taka 3 crore 9 lakh will be spent for 2nd phase work of Khulna divisional museum. Besides this, an archaeological survey will be launched at a cost of Taka 50 lakh.

**PSC violates govt instructions on BCS (Economic) service**

BCS (Economic) cadre officials are reportedly suffering from serious frustration propelled by, as they say, continuing anomaly in their service, reports UNB.

According to some cadre members, this has been affecting the country's aid utilisation programme over the past years.

They alleged that continued encroachment of personnel from other cadres has virtually stalled their promotion during the last seven years.

Outsiders are occupying senior posts in the service depriving the cadre members of their due status, they said.

Members of the cadre said violation of government instructions, one in 1983 and the other in 1990, regarding fixation of seniority and status between cadre members and lateral entrants by the Public Service Commission (PSC) tremendously deteriorated the situation in the service.

The instruction of 1983 said only those lateral entrants in economic service would be regularised who joined before May 12 of 1983.

Later on, another government instruction in 1990 said seniority of lateral entrants would be counted from the date of joining in development projects only when he was incorporated in the revenue budget before May 12, 1983.

But PSC allegedly neglected the instruction and was counting the seniority of the lateral entrants joining the development projects even of those who were incorporated in the revenue budget after May 12, 1983.

As a result, alleged the cadre members, lateral entrants being lower category in qualification and calibre are enjoying senior position in the service.

The violation of government instruction by PSC was identified in a recent investigation report.

Even Prime Minister Khaleda Zia instructed the concerned authorities in February to immediately implement the recommendations of the report and take action against the responsible personnel.

But, according to informed sources, the Prime Minister's order is being overlooked.

The Committee of Secretaries on Administrative Development is scheduled to meet today (Wednesday) to take a decision on the issue.

Sources, however, said some quarters are trying to influence the committee to maintain the status quo in the service structure of the economic cadre.

BCS (Economic) cadre association is learnt to have planned to begin an all out action programme to remove the anomaly in the service which, according to insiders, would heavily affect ADP preparations.

**Prof Akhlaq's death condoled**

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman Tuesday expressed his deep shock at the death of eminent economist and political thinker Dr Akhlaqur Rahman, says a PID handout.

In a message of condolence conveyed from Hong Kong over phone, the Finance Minister recalled his long association with late Akhlaqur Rahman and said that with his death the nation has lost a glorious personality who contributed a lot to the society and the nation.

**Injunction prayer against producer of 'Radha-Krishna' rejected**

The Third Assistant Judge, Dhaka, rejected the injunction prayer yesterday against the producer of the Bengali feature film 'Radha-Krishna'.

Ratan Kumar Sarker, president of Bangladesh Mandir Mission, filed a civil suit in the 3rd Assistant Judge Court on April 20, stating that Fazlur Rashid Dhal produced the feature film with intention to pecuniary gain.

He stated that some of the sequences of the film offended the Hindu devotees and prayed for issuing injunction order upon the producer not to exhibit the film 'Radha-Krishna' in any cinema hall.

The defence lawyer argued that this film was produced on the story based on 'Radha-Krishna' by Indian novelist Sunil Gangopadhyay.

The lawyer further argued that the film was released after approval of the Film Censor Board.

The plaintiff could not find out any objectionable sequence in this film at the time of hearing.

**'Polytechnic institutes to be modernised'**

Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar Tuesday said the present democratic government was firm to establish rule of law for consolidating the process of democracy in the country, reports BSS.

He said the government would not allow anyone to take law into their hands to create disorder.

The Education Minister was addressing as chief guest the installation ceremony of the Central Students Union of Dhaka Polytechnic Institute here.

State Minister for Textile Major(Rtd) M A Mannan, State Minister for Establishment Nurul Huda, State Minister for Shipping Haroon al-Rashid, DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman, MP, President of City JCD Abul Khair Bhuiyan, Secretary Nasiruddin Pintu, Vice-President of the Students Union Ahmad Reza Khan, Secretary Shakil Mahmood and AGS Mahbulul Islam also spoke on the occasion.

The Education Minister said the present government was taking steps to restore academic atmosphere and check violence on the campus. He said the government would introduce a production-oriented education system for materialising the hopes and aspirations of the common people.

He said the polytechnic institutes would be provided with all possible modern educational equipment.

Barrister Sircar said the present government had already taken steps towards fulfilment of election commitments. He opined that the problems of the country were multi-dimensional and these problems would be solved within five years one by one. He also called upon the students to devote themselves to the pursuit of knowledge.

**Case against Zeenat, Mosharraf 5 more witnesses examined**

The trial of the corruption case of Zeenat Mosharraf and her husband A K M Mosharraf Hossain, former Chairman of the Bangladesh Chemical Industries Corporation (BCIC), was held in the court of the 4th Additional District and Sessions Judge, Dhaka yesterday (Tuesday).

Mrs Zeenat Mosharraf was produced before the court yesterday from Dhaka Central Jail. A K M Mosharraf Hossain, husband of Zeenat Mosharraf, was also present before the court yesterday.

The prosecution produced five more witnesses against them. The Court has examined 22 witnesses till yesterday.

Zeenat Mosharraf was arrested on March 13, under the Special Powers Act of 1974 and since then she is in jail custody.

The charge against them were that Zeenat Mosharraf in collusion with her husband maintained ten cars, 6 frigdes and innumerable air-coolers at their residence for their personal use.

As a result, they caused loss to the public exchequer of Tk 4,49,958.96 being the cost of maintenance.
