Subsidy withdrawn from fertilizer will be used to fight poverty : Majed

Agriculture and Irrigation Minister Majedul Huq said here Thursday that the money saved following withdrawal of subsidy from the fertilizer sector, would now be utilised for poverty alleviation and development of education, reports BSS.

Addressing a function, organised in celebration of opening of regional office of International Fertilizer Centre (IFDC) in Bangladesh as the chief guest, the Minister said in this connection that privatisation was possible without creating chaos.

Huq said, the present government had initiated a peaceful transformation from public sector to private sector economic activities as it believed in the policy of market economy.

He said, the edifice of socialist economy has crumbled all over the world. The decision of withdrawal of subsidy from the fertilizer sector and agricultural inputs was a subject of criticism not only from the opposition but also from within the ruling BNP, he recalled. He said, hundreds of crores taka will now be available following withdrawal of subsidy from the fertilizer sector.

He had words of praise for the role of IFDC in Bangladesh for the last 17 years.

The Agriculture Minister expressed the hope that fertilizer would be available at fair price throughout the country provided a good network of dealership system could be developed. The privatisation of fertilizer trade has already created favourable impact in the market, he said.

Agriculture Secretary K M Rabbani, US Ambassador to Bangladesh William B Milam and Director, IFDC Asia Centre, Kenneth L. Moots also addressed the function.

Milam praised the storage capacity of four lakh tonnes of fertilizer through private sector initiatives. Ambassador Milam recalled USAID technical assistance for the agricultural development in Bangladesh.

Kenneth Moots expressed the hope that Bangladesh would soon become a net rice exporter. He said, IFDC is currently working on projects in India, Albania, Indonesia, Malaysia, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Nepal and the Philippines.
