President Abdur Rahman Biswas Friday urged journalists to play the pioneering role in establishing a democratic society to fulfil the hopes and aspirations of the people, who had undergone tremendous sufferings in the past to achieve their democratic rights, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the launching ceremony of "Illustrated Newsweekly" here at a city hotel, the President reminded that the success of democracy achieved through sacrifices of the students and the people depended on the responsible behaviour of all quarters.

Information Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda and Editor of the "Illustrated Newsweekly" Abdur Rahman also spoke on the occasion.

Ministers, diplomats, journalists and the elite of the city were present.

President Biswas said mere voice of protest does not make a nation rather labourious hands make it. So, the journalists should portray the works of those labourious people, he said.

The President said a society free from emotion, youths refraining from anarchy and a consolidated working force were essential to achieve national progress.

He said in the dissemination of world news and information the developing nations should have a dignified position. It cannot be stated in a word that the development efforts of a developing nation are aimed at only meeting its basic needs.

President Biswas emphasised the projection of creative sectors in the developing countries objectively. The free flow of news and information contributes to the growth of democracy and economy, he said, adding but such objectives trend should not be one-sided rather those should reflect the fellow-feeling of the people of all countries.

He said freedom of the press is on priority in all the societies in the world because such freedom contributes to bringing about social welfare.

Speaking on the occasion Information Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda appreciated the efforts towards publishing an English weekly, whose standard, he said, was 'encouraging'.

He expressed the hope that "Illustrated Newsweekly" would project the nation's image abroad through its circulation outside Bangladesh.

The Minister said such a newspaper could write objectively the efforts of a democratic government to achieve national development and help flourish democracy. It also could help project the activities of the opposition in a democratic society.

Barrister Huda said the return of democracy after a nine-year of autocracy in Bangladesh had touched the world. The friendly countries want democracy to survive in Bangladesh, he added.

## Rally on occasion of May Day BSD blasts govt decision to retrench workers

BSD convenor Khalekuzzaman Bhuiyan Thursday denounced the government decision to retrench thousands of workers and said the people had not voted to be repressed by the government.

He was speaking at a workers rally at the Shaheed Nur Hossain Square organised by Samajtantrik Sramik Front on the occasion of the May Day.

He said standard of living of 92 per cent people of Bangladesh had not developed a little during the last 20 years. On the other hand their rights to work were at stake because the World Bank wanted thousands of labourers out of factories, he said.

The rally presided over by Abdullah Sarkar, was addressed among others by Nirmal Sen, Anu Mohammad, Abdur Razzak and Osman Ali.

"We did not vote for World Bank," Khalekuzzaman said. "While the few millionaires are stealing billions, the government is trying to fill that monetary deficit by sacking workers."

He urged the people to build an exploitation free society. Nirmal Sen in his speech said, "Finance Minister Saifur Rahman said there was surplus workers in our factories, but I can challenge his statement that there is no surplus workers in the country," He said, retrenchment on this point was totally illogical.

Enhancement of workers wage Anu Mohammad said, cannot destroy the nation since the majority of the population belongs to the workers. Increase of wage and more job opportunities would improve the country's living standard, he added.

Abdullah Sarkar said if the government did not withdraw the decision of labourer retrenchment, the Samajtantrik Sramik Front will chalk out a massive movement programme against the government after May 22.
