## Setting up of drug courts suggested

A total of eight persons were sentenced to death, three got life-term imprisonment and seven others were given jail terms, ranging between four and 14 years, in connection with different drug related cases since 1989, according to an official statement yesterday, reports BSS.

Abu Taleb, a Deputy Director of the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) speaking at the international training course on drug abuse now being held here, said the judges over burdened with other cases had little time to give attention to drug cases as these were tried in general

He said many judges take lenient view to drug offenders and award inadequate punishment due to less awareness about the curse of drug abuse.

He suggested establishment of special drug courts and appointment of special judges in each regional headquarters of DNC for speedy trial of drug users and traffickers.

The week-long training course for primary health care and prevention professionals in the field of drug abuse in Bangladesh and Nepal is being organised by the International Council on Alcohol and Addictions (ICAA) in cooperation with Palli Shishu Foundation of Bangladesh and supported by the commission of the European Communities.

He said the government was considering a new licensing policy to control manufacture, supply and use of drugs more effectively.
