Companies Act to be updated for betterment of industrial sector

Information Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda Saturday strongly recommended for introduction of cost audit in the country for better social justice and assured his fullest cooperation for "promulgation of Cost Audit Act" to stop unnecessary wastage in the industrial sector.

Inaugurating a six-day workshop on "Strategic Cost Management" at a city hotel here in the afternoon, Barrister Huda, who stressed the need for specialisation in all relevant subjects to deal with the growing complexities of development, also felt the need for updating the Companies Act of 1930.

The Minister said Companies Act of any country is used to serve as a catalyst for better management of industries and financial institutions and the government would update the Act for betterment of industrial sector.

Presided over by Muzaffar Ahmed, President of the Institute of Cost Management Accountants of Bangladesh

(ICMA), the function was attended by Barrister Aminul Hoque, State Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs as the special guest. It was also addressed by Habibur Rahman, Chairman of the Workshop Committee and UNDP representative in Bangladesh Amanullah Khan.

Stressing the need for higher skills and better knowledge of sophisticated techniques, the Information Minister called upon the cost and management accountants to play their due role in national building activities.

He said the cost and management accounting profession was playing its pivotal role in the economic emancipation of country.

He said he would use his good offices for employment of cost and management accountants in different government sectors.

Barrister Aminul Hoque, State Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, said a new Companies Act was a must for the betterment of the

industrial sector in which cost audit rules could be incorporated.

He said to ensure the present government's economic reform, a new Companies Act would be enacted "very soon".

UNDP Representative Amanullah Khan said that his organisation would seek further close collaboration between various agencies like the ICMA, ICAB, various ministries, sector corporations, private enterprises and others in the implementation of the government's policy decisions. He promised further help to the institute.

Muzaffar Ahmed appealed to the government to amend the Companies Act of 1930, saying that while the age-old act was amended in all the neighbouring countries, it was still in force in Bangladesh.

Ahmed explained that for better skill and management of the industrial sector the act should be amended.

The workshop is being jointly organised by ICMA and UNDP.

Stabbing of DU reporter condemned

The Dhaka University Journalists' Association Saturday condemned the stabbing of one of its members in an armed attack on Friday, reports UNB.

In a statement, DUJA President Moazzam Hossain and General Secretary Rezaul Karim Lotus demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of those involved in the attack on Dainik Sangram's DU Correspondent Rezaul Islam Reza.

An armed group took Reza into the guest room of Jashimuddin Hall and beat and stabbed him seriously. The miscreants also shaved his head, eyebrow and moustache.

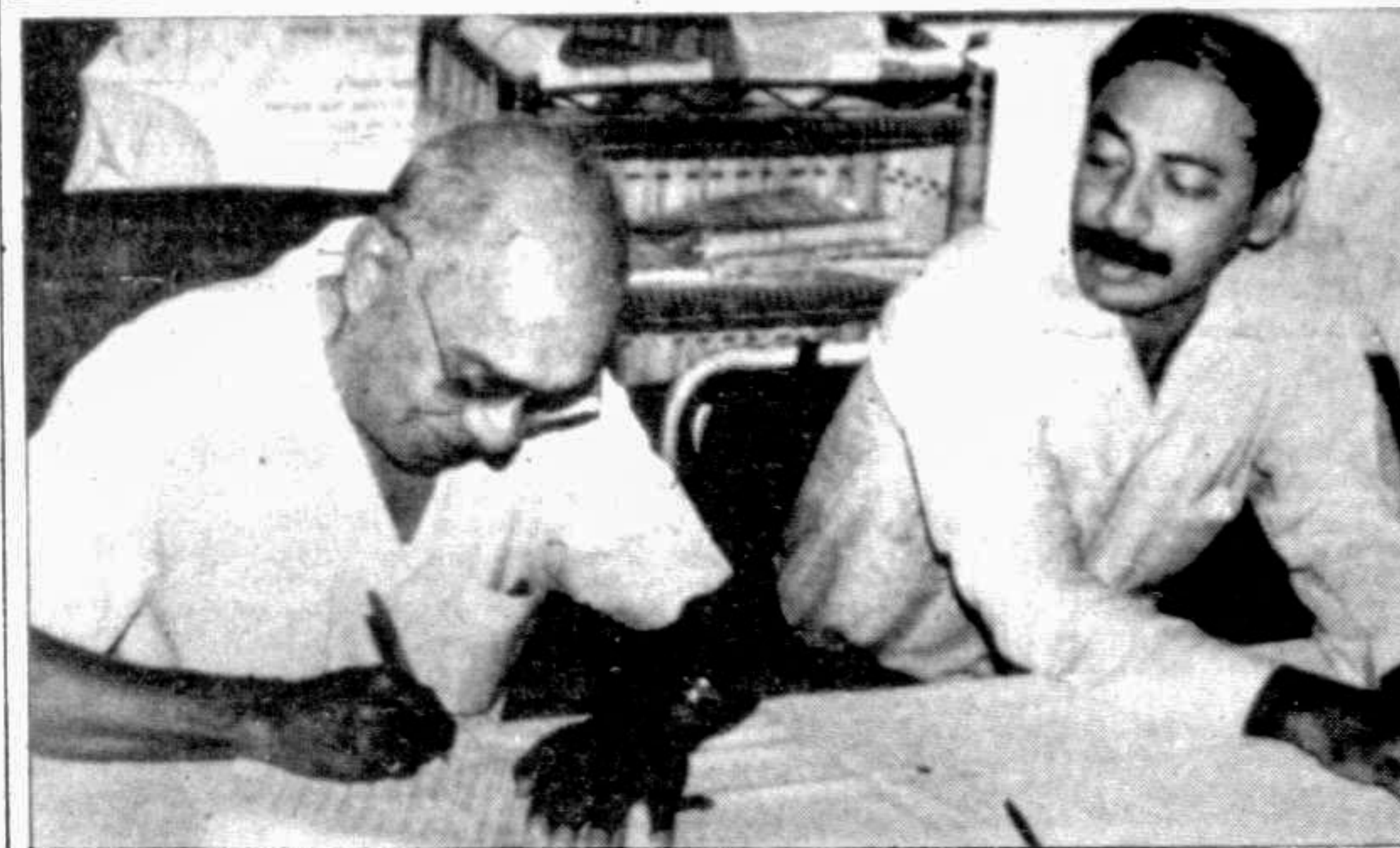
Dacoity at Makid Haider's house

The Bakhunda bridge on the Faridpur-Barisal highway built at a cost of Tk 3.90 crore was opened to traffic Saturday, reports UNB.

Communication Minister Col (Retd) Oli Ahmed inaugurated the bridge, saying better communication is the precondition of economic development.

Despite resource constraints the present government spent Tk 823 crore in the communication sector in last one year to improve the communication network countrywide, he told a gathering on the occasion at Bakhunda High School.
