Stressing the need for higher skills and better knowledge of sophisticated techniques, the Information Minister called upon the cost and management accountants to play their due role in national building activities.

industrial sector in which cost audit rules could be incorporated.


He said to ensure the present government's economic reform, a new Companies Act would be enacted "very soon."
