

Petroleum dealers threaten strike

Bangladesh Petroleum Dealers Association at a meeting Sunday threatened to go on strike if the government did not fulfil their demands by June 30.

The demands of the Association include enhancement of commission for the dealers, measures against illegal toll collection and an end to the harassment by certain government agencies.

The meeting held at Hotel Sundarban at 6 pm was addressed, among others, by Azizul Huq MP, Harun-or-Rashid, Alhaj Mahbubur Rahman, Montu Chowdhury, Abdur Rahman, Nazmul Huq and Col (Retd) Abdur Rahman with Advocate Abdul Kalam Azad in the chair.

Credit by Scheduled Banks stands at Tk 23124 crore

The credit provided in Bangladesh by the Scheduled Banks at the close of business on May 7 stood at Taka 23124 crore.

Their cash in the country was Taka 335.73 crore. This included Taka 328.50 crore as Bangladesh notes and Taka 7.23 crore as Bangladeshi Taka coins.

The banks' borrowings from the central bank were Taka 3904.08 crore. These included Taka 159 crore against promissory notes and the rest as other borrowings.

The demand liabilities of the banks were Taka 5646.97 crore. These included Taka 4241.14 crore as general deposits, Taka 141.35 crore as deposits from banks, Taka 100 crore as borrowings from banks and Taka 1164.48 crore as other demand liabilities.

The time liabilities stood at Taka 1992.38 crore. These included Taka 18586.66 crore as general deposits, Taka 170 crore as deposits from banks and Taka 1235.72 crore as other time liabilities.

Their balances with the central bank stood at Taka 1875.46 crore while balances with other banks in current account stood at Taka 121.59 crore.

Money at call and short notice in Bangladesh stood at Taka 221.55 crore. Their investments were Taka 4570.53 crore.

The weighted average price of the accepted bids was Tk 98.62 per 100 taka. The corresponding yield is 5.61 per annum.

A BB press release said eight bids with a face value of Tk 30 crore were accepted.

Eighteen bids for a total of Tk 110 crore were received at the 18th auction of the 91-day Bangladesh Bank (BB) bill held in Dhaka on Monday, reports UNB.

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External balances fall slightly

The balance held outside Bangladesh by the Bangladesh Bank slightly came down compared to the previous weeks and stood at Taka 4971.36 crore on May 7.

The asset side of the Banking Department showed notes of Taka 8.23 lakh, subsidiary coin holding of Taka one thousand, government treasury bills holdings of Taka 301.82 crore. Other loans and advances stood at Taka 1072.42 crore, investments amounted to Taka 561.83 crore and other assets stood at Taka 1637.96 crore.

On the liabilities side, the deposits stood at Taka 6505.60 crore.

Allocation of Special Drawing Rights stood at Taka 91.74 crore, bills payable were of Taka 105.20 crore and other liabilities stood at Taka 1392.03 crore.

In the credit sectors, Rural Credit Fund was Taka 185.14 crore, Industrial Credit Fund amounted to Taka 51.78 crore, Export Credit Fund was Taka 53 crore and Agricultural Credit Stabilisation Fund stood at Taka 175 crore.

The Capital Paid Up and Reserve Fund as usual stood at Taka three crore each.

The liabilities side of the Issue Department of the bank showed Taka 4000.06 crore as notes in circulation.

The asset side of the Issue Department showed gold and bullion holding of Taka 83.85 crore, Taka 200 crore as approved foreign exchange, Taka 5.74 crore as Taka-coin holding, Taka 367.45 crore as government securities holding and Taka 3343.08 crore as internal bills of exchange and other commercial papers.
