'Govt pledge-bound to improve weavers' lot'

Textile Minister Major (ret'd) Abdul Mannan Wednesday said that the government was determined to improve the socio-economic condition of the weavers as they produce seventy per cent of cloth required for the country, reports BSS.

The minister was speaking at a Weavers Representative Conference organised by Bangladesh Handloom Board at WAPDA auditorium in Dhaka.

Among others, the conference was addressed by Abdul Ali Mridha, Selima MF, Textile

Secretary Ershadul Haq, Chairman, Handloom Board Gr Capt. (ret'd) Enamul Hoq Chowdhury and representatives of the weavers.

The Textile Minister said that the government had taken an extensive programme for the development of handloom industry and improvement of the lot of the weavers.

In this context, he mentioned the allocation of Taka 147 crore for implementing eight handloom development projects during the fourth five year plan.

Mokbulur Jute Mills leaders threaten action from tomorrow

CHITTAGONG, May 27: CBA leaders of Mokbulur Rahman Jute Mills warned that they would go for action programme from May 29 if the authorities do not take steps to pay their last month's salary, reports UNB.

In a press statement Tuesday, CBA president Dalilur Rahman and secretary Abul Mansur said about 3,000 workers of the mills are yet to receive their salary of the month of April.

They said they would be compelled to put barricade on Dhaka-Chittagong highway for an indefinite period if their demand is not met immediately.

CBA also demanded government intervention in this connection.
