'Zia's political philosophy to guide nation even after 50 years'

Professor of Political Science of Dhaka University Dr Emajuddin Ahmed said yesterday that the political scientists after 50 years would find the political philosophy of late President Ziaur Rahman worthy for that time.
He was addressing a discussion meeting organised by Zia Parishad held at the Shishu Academy auditorium in the city in observance of the 11th death anniversary of President Ziaur Rahman.
Termed late Zia among those few great men of this soil who would be remembered for ever, Dr Ahmed lauded Zia's political thoughts and termed those very pragmatic.

50,000 Rohingyas entered after signing accord

The number of Rohingya Muslim refugees who crossed into Bangladesh from neighbouring Myanmar swelled to 2,65,080 on Saturday, officials said in Dhaka Sunday, reports UNB.
The Muslims from Arakan in Myanmar continued to pour into Bangladesh unabated to escape persecution despite the agreement concluded between the two countries on April 28 stipulating their repatriation.
About 50 thousand Rohingyas entered Bangladesh since the accord was signed.
Dhaka, under the agreements, is committed to ensuring "safe and voluntary return" of tens of thousands of the Myanmar Muslims sheltered in Bangladesh to their homes and is proceeding accordingly.
The agreements mainly envisage four objectives such as halt of the influx, return of the refugees with security and dignity, defusing tension along the border and a permanent solution of the problem to stop recurrence of the exodus of the refugees.

Ceramic goods worth Tk 16 lakh seized in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, June 1: The anti-smuggling and rummage teams of Chittagong Customs in a special tip-off recovered huge quantity of ceramic goods worth about Taka 16 lakh from a foreign ship at the outer anchorage of the port here last night, reports BSS.
According to a customs press release, today, the goods recovered included flower-vase, horse, elephant made of ceramic which were hidden in different secret chambers of the ship.
Besides, Detective Branch of Chittagong Metropolitan Police also recovered 40 mini carton contraband cigarettes worth Taka 30,000 from Station Road here under Kotwali police.

Situation in Dainik Bangla, Times reviewed

Leaders of journalists and press unions at a joint meeting here Monday reviewed the situation prevailing in the Bangladesh Times and Dainik Bangla and urged for early resolution of the problems in the two dailies, reports UNB.

Presided over by BFUJ president Reazuddin Ahmed the meeting hoped that necessary steps will be taken soon for permanent solution of the problems in the two newspapers.
