

### JU admission test begins June 6

The postponed admission tests of the first year honours classes of Jahangirnagar University will begin from June 6.

Examination to the Kha, Ga and Oha units will now be held on June 6, 7 and 8 respectively.

Admission committee has published the seat arrangement chart. Tests will now be held in two shifts: morning shift between 9.30 am and 12.30 pm and the day shift between 1 pm and 4 pm.

The admission tests were earlier postponed following transport workers-students clash on May 11.

### Protect rights of women, children: Mustafiz

Foreign Minister A S M Mustafizur Rahman Tuesday laid stress on the need for safeguarding the rights of women and children for the overall development of the manpower resources, reports BSS.

Inaugurating the first, ever Commonwealth South Asian regional workshop on the protection of the rights of women and children here, he said problems of women and children represented a major issue for the developing nations and this had to be dealt with all seriousness.

The workshop, being held under the aegis of the Commonwealth Secretariat, London, is being attended by

government and non-government delegates from Bangladesh, India, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

The Foreign Minister said the workshop was very timely for the participating nations of the Commonwealth since protection of rights of women and children figured in the deliberation of the Commonwealth meetings.

He said the Commonwealth Ministers for Women Affairs in Ottawa had prepared a programme of action which was subsequently endorsed by the last Commonwealth summit in Harare.

The comprehensive programme of action, he said, aimed at reforming social, administrative and legal structures to give women full and effective rights to land, finance and other resources.

These measures, the Foreign Minister said, would remove barriers to women's ability to participate in productive activities of the society.

Rahman said equal emphasis should be laid on the rights and development of the children and Bangladesh is committed to the protection of rights of both women and children.

### Govt urged to withdraw special facilities of tribal people

Parbatya Gano Parishad Tuesday called upon the government to withdraw special facilities provided to the tribal people, reports UNB.

"There cannot be separate law for a particular community when all are equal in the eyes of law", the speakers at a protest rally here said adding that there should not be any discrimination between the tribals and non-tribals.

The rally was organised by Parbatya Gano Parishad to protest the killing and subversive activities by the outlawed Shantibahini in Chittagong Hill Tract areas and the support extended to them by a group of people including some political leaders.

Speaking at the rally JAGPA Chief Shaful Alam Pradhan criticised Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia for not raising the issue of alleged patronisation of Shantibahini by India at the talks she had with her Indian counterpart in New Delhi recently.

Pradhan said both Khaleda and Hasina kept silent when Shantibahini terrorists killed any non-tribal but raised their voice when a tribal was killed.

Blaming India for patronising the outlawed terrorists in the hill areas, JAGPA chief said people would fight for safeguarding their independence and sovereignty.

### DESA extends date for payment of arrears without surcharge

DESA authority has extended the time-limit for payment of arrears electricity bill without surcharge up to June 20, says a press release.

Earlier the date of payment of bills was fixed up to May 31. The date has been extended at the request of the valued consumers and circles. The consumers can pay their bills without surcharge at their respective Bank branches.

### CMP recovers 400 Indian sarees

### Tk 7.83 cr book promotional projects undertaken

The government has undertaken two book promotional projects at a cost of Tk 7.83 crore under the Fourth Five-Year Plan period, an official handout said, reports BSS.

This was stated at the 5th meeting of the parliamentary Standing Committee on the Cultural Affairs Ministry held Tuesday at the Sangsad Bhavan in Dhaka with State Minister for Cultural Affairs Professor Jahannara Begum in the chair.

The committee was informed that one project of Tk six crore was taken up for the district and thana level libraries to provide assistance of book, furniture and construction and renovation materials. Besides, another project of Tk 1.83 crore had been undertaken to implement programmes of book promotion.

The meeting was also informed that two acres of land had been selected at Agargaon in Dhaka for the construction of National Archives Building and the proposal was under active consideration of the government during the 4th Five-Year-Plan period. The National Library has collected 1,50,000 books while the National Archives has collected four lakh volumes of old documents.

### Need for taking vocational training stressed

Social Welfare and Women Affairs Minister Tariqul Islam has urged the NGOs working in Bangladesh to strengthen development oriented motivational activities to help make the people a working community, reports BSS.

He was speaking at a certificate distribution ceremony of a training course organised by the Youth Academy here Monday.

The minister stressed the need for taking vocational training courses by the unemployed youths as government alone cannot provide all of them in public services.

He distributed certificates among the trainees who have successfully completed different vocational courses.

The minister also inaugurated the activities of a new NGO based in Dhaka, named 'Equilibre'. Equilibre is working here for the handicapped people.

Later Islam visited the training centre of the Youth Academy and workshop of the Equilibre.

Director General of the NGO Affairs Bureau Mohammad Shahidul Alam and representative of the Equilibre Laurent Le Danois were present on the occasion.
