These measures, the Foreign Minister said, would remove barriers to womens ability to participate in productive activities of the society. Pradhan said both Khalcda and Hasina kept silent when Shantibahini terrorists killed any non-tribal but raised their voice when a tribal was killed.

Blaming India for patronising the outlawed terrorists in the hill areas, JAGPA chief said people would fight for safeguarding their independence and sovereignty.


