Ganatantri Party demands UN role in Rohingya repatriation

Ganatantri Party has demanded involvement of United Nations in the Rohingya refugee repatriation process to overcome prevailing deterrents, reports UNB.

The party at its central executive committee meeting on Friday expressed concern over the present situation and observed "the anti-liberation communal forces and their international mentors are instigating the refugees not to go back home."

Chaired by party chief Ahmedul Kabir, the meeting also demanded trial of Pakistani citizen Golam Azam, withdrawal of the cases against the sponsors 'people's court' and ban on activities of communal forces.

Expressing concern over the present situation in the Chittagong Hill Tracts, the meeting suggested a political solution of the problem within the purview of the sovereignty of Bangladesh.

'REB plays vital role for small industries'

Industries Minister Shamsul Islam Khan has said that Rural Electrification Board (REB) is playing very important role for the development of small and cottage industries and modernised cultivation in the rural areas, reports BSS.

He said this while addressing the foundation laying ceremony of a 33/11 KV power sub-station at Singair Sunday. Presided over by President of the Manikganj Palli Bidyut Samity Fazul Karim, the function was also addressed by Chairman, REB Brigadier Zahed Latif.

The Industries Minister said, with the completion of the sub-station 11 lakh people of the locality will be benefited directly. He said that the construction work of the sub-station would be completed at a cost of Taka one crore by November next. Fourteen hundred kilometre distribution line will also be set up phase by phase, the Industries Minister added.

The minister further said that the present democratic government is committed to developing the rural areas on priority basis. He urged the local rich people to come forward for setting up small and cottage industries in the rural areas for making the rural electrification programme a success.

'Health Care Committee for harlots to prevent AIDS'

Deputy Leader in the House Professor Badruddoza Chowdhury said in Dhaka Sunday that formation of "Health Care Committee" for the prostitutes could play a supportive role in the prevention of AIDS, reports BSS.

He was making his presidential speech at an emergency meeting of national AIDS Committee here at the conference room of World Health Organisation.

Prof. Chowdhury stressed on taking programmes by the NGOs in fields where there was no government programme in checking AIDS.

HBFC resumes lending from July 15

The House Building Finance Corporation (HBFC) will resume lending for construction of Houses in the city and elsewhere from July 15, an official yesterday said.

More than 10,000 applicants have been awaiting for loans as fresh lending was suspended in 1989 for lack of funds.

HBFC Managing Director Hayatullah Rahman told UNB that Tk. 1450.50 crore was lying outstanding to about 40,000 borrowers across the country.

He said a "miss-match" between lending and borrowing resulted in an annual loss to the tune of Tk. 50 crore over the last about 18 years.

Fire at AJM colony Probe body formed

NARAYANGANJ, June 7: A five-member probe body headed by Nurul Alam, Manager (Administration) of the Adamjee Jute Mills (AJM) has been formed today to investigate into the devastating fire at a workers' colony of the AJM yesterday.

The fire gutted some 1,000 thatched houses of the Bazu Workers' Colony of the AJM leaving nearly 10 thousand people homeless.

The probe body was formed jointly by the district administration and the AJM authorities.

The homeless people were starving and lying under open sky since no relief goods reached them till today.

The State Minister for Relief Lutfur Rahman Khan while visiting the spot this afternoon allocated cash money of taka two lakh, 200 bundles of car-rugated tin, 300 tons of rice, 500 pieces of sarees and 500 pieces of lungis for the victims.

Relief materials sanctioned by the local administration did not reach the fire victims as the trade union leaders of the mills rejected the goods terming it as inadequate.

Meanwhile, the casualties in yesterday's fire have not yet been assessed officially.
