Girls' school to be set up after Toaha

Jatiya Sangsad Speaker Shaikh Razak Ali yesterday accepted donation of a piece of land at Ramgati upazila to found a girls' school after the name of the late left politician Mohammad Toaha.

The Speaker made the announcement while speaking at the inaugural function of Toaha Smriti Pathagar as chief guest at the Joginagar Lane residence of late Toaha.

Earlier in the function, widow of late Toaha Arjahan Toaha announced her donation of land at Hajirhat of Ramgati upazila and sought co-operation of the government and others concerned to establish the school with a view to preserving late Toaha's memory.

The Speaker also announced a donation of Taka 10,000 for the proposed school on his behalf.

Acting President of Awami League and Deputy Leader of the Opposition Abdus Samad Azad, CPB President Saifuddin Ahmed Manik, Pankaj Bhattacharya of NAP, Dr Anisuzzaman of the Dhaka University, Shaifur Rahman Majumder and Abdur Rouf of Bangladesh Samajbadi Dal and other political comrades of the late politician also spoke on the occasion.

Samad Azad announced his personal donation of Taka one thousand for the proposed girls school after Toaha's name.

Saifuddin Ahmed Manik stressed the need for writing books on the late politician with a view to preserving his memories and contributions to the country's progressive movement.

Govt urged to sanction Tk 15 cr for Ad sector in coming fiscal

Bangladesh Sangbadpatri Parishad has put forward various demands, including increased advertisement rate and decreased service charges, for alleviating problems facing the newspaper industry, reports UNB.

It demanded of the government to sanction Tk 15 crore for the public sector advertisement in the coming 1992-93 fiscal year.

The demands were carried in a memorandum submitted to Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia on Saturday by an eight-member delegation from the industry, said a BSP press release Monday.

BSP President Barrister Moinal Hossain and Secretary General Anwarul Islam, Bangladesh Editors Council President Sanaullah Nuri and Secretary General AQM Jaiunul Abedin, BFUJ President Rezauddin Ahmed and Secretary General Amanullah Kabir, DUJ General Secretary Mia and General Secretary Altaf Mahmud were in the delegation.

To improve the quality of newspapers, they also recommended either improvement of the quality local newsprint or duty-free import of the paper.

The leaders also demanded the minimum advertisement rate of Tk 200 per column-inch and fixation of advertisement rate on the basis of the scale of circulation of newspapers.

They also sought cooperation of the government in getting rid of the monopoly of the Newspaper Hawkers' Association.

The leaders expressed the conviction that all implementation of the Press Commission Report could solve all problems facing the newspaper industry.

To improve the quality of newspapers, they also recommended either improvement of the quality local newsprint or duty-free import of the paper.

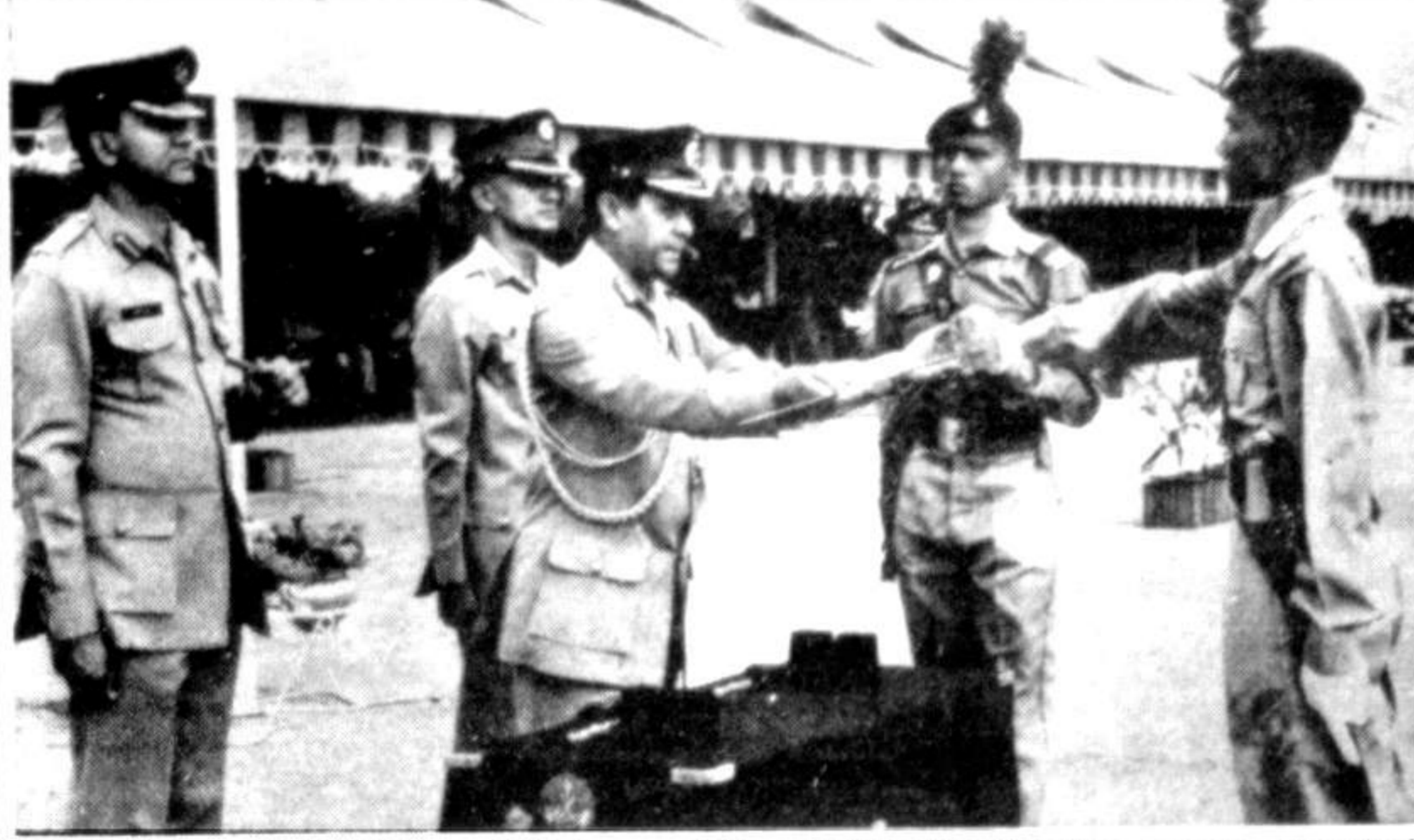

National Board of Revenue Notice

The date for advance income tax payment for the 4th quarter of the current financial year is June 15, 1992. The advance income tax payable by the concerned tax-payer is paid through I T Form No-1-T-31 (B) (Amended) challan. The tax-payers should pay the advance tax filling in the said challan form as usual by replacing the figure "74(1)" with the figure "64" in as many places it occurs in the form.

It may be mentioned that the financial limit of total income for payment of advance income tax is as follows:

- (A) For companies resident in Bangladesh Taka 20 thousand.
- (B) For non-resident assesses Taka 5 thousand.
- (C) For other assesses Taka 60 thousand.

All assesses concerned are requested to pay their advance income tax for the 4th quarter of the current financial year relevant to the assessment year 1992-93 under this system by June 15, 1992.

Simple interest @18% per annum will be leviable if the advance income tax is not paid or paid at a lesser amount than due.
