

## Notice for the Admission into BDS Course in the Dental Colleges

Memo No DGHS/ME-17/92/7846

Dated: 2.6.92

Applications are invited in prescribed form for admission into the 1st year BDS class of the Dental Colleges for the session 1991-92.

The candidates must be citizens of Bangladesh except for the 5 (five) seats in the Dhaka Dental College reserved for foreign students.

The candidates must have passed the SSC examination in any group and HSC examination having Physics, Chemistry & Biology or its equivalent from the recognised Boards of the Intermediate & Secondary Education or Universities of Bangladesh and must have obtained at least 1200 marks (without grace mark, extra mark and deduction for irregularity as explained in para 10 and without third division) in the combined total of SSC & HSC results. The tribal candidates who have passed the SSC & HSC examinations both at least in the 2nd division are eligible to apply.

There will be in all 94 seats in Dental Colleges of Bangladesh i.e. 54 seats in the Dhaka Dental College, 20 seats in Chittagong Dental College & 20 seats in Rajshahi Dental College (excluding the reserved seats for the tribal and foreign students).

The above mentioned 94 seats will be distributed in 3 Dental Colleges of Bangladesh.

- Candidates passing SSC examination prior to 1987 and HSC prior to 1989 will not be eligible to apply.
- 1 (one) seat will be kept reserved for tribal candidate at Dhaka Dental College. 94 seats for local students will be filled up on the basis of national merit.
- Candidates for admission into the three Dental Colleges for the session 1991-92 will obtain the prescribed form of application from any of the Dental Colleges and shall submit the filled in forms in the same Dental College with the attested copies of certificates and documents with centre fee of Taka 230/only.
- The selection of students for admission into the Dental Colleges in the session 1991-92 will be made strictly on the basis of the result of the following examinations:

100 marks 

(Physics 30, Chemistry 30, Biology 30 and English 10)

Viva-Voce examination . . . . . . .

20 marks 1% (one per cent) of the total marks obtained combinedly both SSC & HSC i.e. 20 marks. (Total marks allotted for a, b, c are 140).

Merit of the candidates will be decided on the basis of the result of written test (MCQ), Viva Voce and adding 1% of the total marks obtained in SSC & HSC examinations except in case of tie, when total marks of Physics, Chemistry and Biology obtained in HSC examination will be considered. In case of tie again marks obtained in Biology in HSC examination will be considered.

A list of 94 selected candidates and a waiting list consisting 125 candidates (in order of merit) will be notified at the first instance. The marksheets of all candidates appearing in the admission test will be hung up in the notice board of all the Dental Colleges.

Processing & scrutiny of applications for admission, moderation of question papers, examining & marking of answer sheets and selection of candidates will be done by the computer. Results produced by OMR can not be challenged in any court of law. But if any candidate objects as to the correctness of his/her result, he/she may apply for reviewing the result within 15 days of publication of result to the Director, Medical Education, Directorate General of Health Services, Mohakhali, Dhaka. The application must be supported by a Bank Draft amounting to Tk 500/- (Taka five hundred only), issued in favour of Director, Medical Education (the money is non-refundable). The review committee will let the candidate know about the result within 1 month of the application.

Candidates who passed HSC examination in the current calendar year i.e. 1991 and SSC examination in 1989 will be considered as regular. A candidate who has passed SSC examination prior to 1989 & HSC prior to 1991 will be considered as irregular.

- 11. The choice of college will be decided on the basis of merit and preference given by the candidate in the application form. Candidate will offer one or more choices in the application as he/she likes. He/she will cross out the college where he/she is not offering any choice.
- Prescribed application forms will be available in the offices of the Dental Col-

fee in cash. Application complete in all respect will be received by the Principals of re-

leges of Bangladesh on payment of Tk 20/- (Taka twenty) only as Registration

spective Dental Colleges from where the application forms were supplied. At the time of submission of application Tk 230/- (Taka two hundred & thirty) only will be payable in cash has centre fee.

14. A full list of all eligible candidates who will appear in written and Viva-Voce examination will be available in the offices of the Dental Colleges where they will submit the applications before due date of examination.

- The written and Viva Voce test will be held in the respective Dental Colleges where they will submit application form for admission. MCQ type of question will be set for the written test. Further information regarding admission will be available in the offices of the Dental Colleges.
- No prayer for change of district, change of choice of Dental College and change of district for reserved seat will be entertained after the submission of application form.
- Final selection of candidates is subject to medical fitness as decided by a medical board.
- All certificates/documents in original are to be submitted at the time of admission failing which the applicant's candidature will be rejected.
- Completed application in prescribed form is to be submitted in the Dental College from where the form was collected. All applications must be accompanied by the following documents:

Attested photostat copy of SSC examination certificate.

- Attested photostat copy of the certificate of passing HSC examination
- from the Principal of the college from which he/she passed the HSC examination.
- Attested photostat copies of SSC & HSC marksheets.
- Attested copy of certificate from the Head of the Institution in which the applicant studied last regarding his/her character, personality, carrier and extra curriculum activities.
- Attested copy of nationality certificate.
- Tribal candidates shall have to furnish eligibility/character certificate (in original) from the Deputy Commissioner of the district concern and also from the concerned tribal chief testifying that he/she is a tribal candidate of that district. These certificates must be submitted in the prescribed forms available in the offices of the Principal of the Dental
- 3 (three) attested copies of recent passport size photograph. One of these photographs will be returned to the candidate with signature and seal of the Principal/an officer authorised by the Principal. This will be retained by the candidate for use as an identity card to be produced as and when necessary. This admit card (bearing registration number) along with the admit card issued by the college authority will have to be shown to the invigilator at the time of written and Viva Voce exami-
- nation. Acknowledgement slips showing the payment of Taka 20/- (Taka twenty) only as registration fee and Tk 230/- (Taka two hundred & thirty) only as centre fee.
- Certificate of permanent district of the candidate from MP/Zila Parishad Chairman/Class-I Gazetted Officer/Chairman, Municipality/Chairman, Union Council and in respect of the candidates of Bandarban, Khagrachhari and Chittagong Hill Tracts, the original certificates from the Deputy Commissioner of the district of the candidates.
- Applications received after the expiry of the last date and time will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will be treated as cancelled.
- 21. All information regarding admission will be found on the notice board of the Dental Colleges. No correspondence in connection with admission will be made at the address of the candidate.
- Those who will be selected from the waiting list, their names will be published in the newspaper & also the notice board of Dental Colleges.
- Application for migration in the first year BDS class may be invited by notification by the Principal after expected withdrawals have been completed, before admission from the waiting list. This chance for migration will be allowed once only and will be considered on the basis of merit and choice.
- Apart from migration system as stated in Para 23, migration may also be allowed for the 2nd, 3rd & 4th year students only from one Dental College to another (except Dhaka Dental College). In such cases the students who will fulfil certain conditions, as laid down by Govt may apply to the Principal of their respective Dental College in the prescribed form for migration.
- Because of the scarcity of seats in the hostel, students admitted in the Dental College will have to arrange their own accommodation.
- 26. After passing the final BDS examination, the newly passed doctors will have to take internship training in the hospital of the Dental College from which they passed. They will not be allowed to transfer to any other Dental College Hospitals for the purpose of internship training. After the completion of internship, there is no guarantee of Govt Service.
- 27. The last date of receipt of applications by the offices of the Principals of Dental Colleges is 30-6-92 up to office hour.
- 28. The written test will be held on Friday, the 24-7-92 at 9 AM with duration of 1 hour 20 minute. The date of Viva-Voce test will be announced by the Principal of the respective Dental College in the College Notice Board. (The candidates will have to bring with them "2B" pencil, eraser/rubber and sharpner).
