CHITTAGONG, June 14: Eid-ul-Azha, one of the two major festivals of the Muslims, was celebrated here today with religious fervour and festivity, reports BSS.

The main Eid congregation in the port city was held inside the Jamaatul Falah complex at 7 am because of inclement weather. The acting khatib of the complex led the prayer. State Minister for Jute Abdul Mannan, City Mayor Mir Mohammad Nasiruddin were among prominent who offered their prayer at the complex.

The second largest Eid congregation was held at the local Circuit House compound at 7:30 am under the auspices of Chittagong central Eid Jamaat committee. Khatib of Andarkillah Shahi Jam-e-Masjid Alhaj Abdul Ahahad Al-Madani led the prayer.

**No major change in rivers'
positions**

Despite light to heavy rainfall in the Meghna and the Brahmaputra basins during the last 24 hours there has been no appreciable changes in the positions of rivers under these two basins, reports BSS.

However, as a result of light to moderately heavy rainfall at most of places over the Ganges and the South Eastern Hill basins during the same period, most rivers under these basins registered rises. Some of course recorded slight falls.

According to Flood Information Centre (FIC) of Bangladesh Water Development Board, the general condition of rivers are: the Brahmaputra is falling at most of the points and the Ganges showing rising trend except at Hardinge Bridge. It said the

Manu receded during the period, while levels of major and other rivers are lower than that of last year of the same period.

Though light to heavy rainfall has been recorded at most places over the Meghna basin, the Manu recorded fall by 40 cm at the Manu Railway Bridge and 22 cm at Moulvibazar, the rivers Surma and Kushiya under this basin registered rises from 7 cm to 68 cm at different places, the rivers Khowai and Gumti at Habiganj and Comilla respectively receded, the FIC press release said.

Although the Brahmaputra registered slight rise as a result of light to heavy rainfall, the Teesta, the old Brahmaputra, the Buriganga and the Lakhya receded.

**Two stabbed to
death in Ctg**

CHITTAGONG, June 14: Two persons were stabbed to death and another was injured critically at north middle Halishahar yesterday, reports BSS.

According to the police, when two brothers Abdul Hakim and Abu Taher were returning home after Eid prayer a group of armed people, chased them and stabbed one after another. The two brothers died on the spot and Abdur Rashid their distant relative was injured.
