

Amendment to Family Court Ordinance demanded

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad President Begum Suifa Kamal and General Secretary Ayesha Khanam in a statement on Wednesday expressed grave concern over the recent price hike of the essential commodities.

The statement observed that the price hike on the eve of announcing the national budget had become a regular phenomenon in the country. It also blamed the government for imposing taxes on various commodities before the budget in an undemocratic way and said this had aggravated the sufferings of the people of limited income.

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad submitted a set of recommendations to the Deputy Leader of the Parliament on June 11 for bringing some amendments to the existing law to establish equal right and dignity of the women folk.

The recommendations include amendment to the Family Court Ordinance and introduction of family code. Vice President of the organisation Munira Khan, Chitra Bhattacharya, Bela Nabil, General Secretary Ayesha Khanam and Secretary Rina Hela handed over the recommendations on behalf of the Mahila Parishad.

Jamaat supports June 20 hartal

Jamaat-e-Islami has extended support to the half-day hartal on June 20 called by Jatiya Jubo Command and Bharatiya Dalal Protrroth Committee, reports UNB.

In a joint statement Wednesday Jamaat Acting Ameer Abbas Ali Khan and Secretary General Matur Rahman Nizami appealed to the people to observe the hartal as a mark of protest against anarchy and disorder let loose across the country by the sponsors of "so-called Gano Adalat (People's Court)".

"They have made the public life intolerable during the last four months by resorting to anarchy and illegal activities", the statement said.

The Jamaat leaders were critical of the government for what they said "patronising" such activities.

Free judiciary from the executive: Bar leaders

Some leading Bar leaders have urged the government and the parliament to establish rule of law and ensure independence of the judiciary from the executive, reports BSS.

Addressing a joint press conference at the Jatiya Press Club Wednesday they placed a five-point recommendation aimed at materialisation of the pledges made to the people during the democratic movement. They also stressed the need for restoration of the 1972 Constitution.

Kamal Hossain, Syed Ishtiaq Ahmed, Shamsul Huq Chowdhury, Sudhansu Shekhar Halder MP and Barrister Amrul Islam addressed the press conference. The Bar leaders expressed

their grave concern over what they described as deteriorating law and order situation. In this connection, they recalled their experiences of visit to several Bar Associations during the recently held bar council elections.

The recommendations of the Bar leaders, include the shifting of upazila courts, both civil and criminal to the district headquarters, separation of the judiciary from the executive, regular inspection of the subordinate courts by judges of the Supreme Court and financial support to Bar Associations for the growth of legal profession and legal aid schemes through Bar Associations in their respective areas.
