Anti-Drug Day observed. Call for checking drug abuse, illicit trafficking

As elsewhere in the world, the international Anti-Drug Day was observed in Bangladesh yesterday with a call for carrying vigorous campaign against drug abuse and illicit trafficking.

President Abdur Rahman Biswas and the Prime Minister Khaleda Zia gave separate messages on the occasion, calling for checking drug abuse and illicit traffickings.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia addressed a discussion meeting at the Osmany Memorial Auditorium in the afternoon. Arranged by the Directorate of Narcotics control, the meeting was also addressed by the Home Minister Abdur Matin Choudhury.

She called upon all political parties and the socio-cultural organisations to build up a strong movement and resistance against drug addiction on the basis of national consensus.

Earlier in the morning, the Narcotics Department also arranged a 'padajatra' or walkathon from the Shishu Park to the Osmany Memorial Hall. Home Minister Abdur Matin Choudhury, Social Welfare and Women Affairs Minister Tariqul Islam, Works Minister Rafiqul Islam Miah and the Mayor of the Dhaka City Corporation Mirza Abbas led the 'padajatra'.

The Narcotics Control Department and the Narcotic Officers Welfare Association published two souvenirs to mark the occasion.

The United Nations Association of Bangladesh (UNAB) held a symposium in the United Nation Information Centre (UNIC) premises in observance of the international day against drug abuse and illicit trafficking in the morning.

UNAB President and eminent scientist Prof M Innas Ali presided over the symposium while it was also addressed by, among others, UNDP's Deputy Resident Representative Wolfgang Fischer, Prof AK Azad Choudhury of the Dhaka University, Dr Nargis Ratan and UNAB Secretary General Syed Ahmed Hossain.

Wolfgang Fischer in his speech spoke on different sides of drug abuse and particularly mentioned about the gigantic role of the United Nations system in combating drug abuse and illicit trafficking of drugs throughout the world.

- ডায়াবেটিস রোগ নির্ণয় ও নিয়ন্ত্রণে জনসাধারণের করণীয়: ১) রোগের লক্ষণ দেখা দিলে অবিলম্বে নিকটস্থ হাসপাতালে কিংবা ডায়াবেটিক চিকিৎসা কেন্দ্রে রক্ত ও প্রসাব পরীক্ষা করানো এবং ডাক্তারের পরামর্শ নেয়া। ২) চর্নিশ বন্ধ ব্যায়ামের বেশী হলে কসরতে অস্বস্তি একবার রক্তে পরীক্ষা করানো। ৩) ডায়াবেটিস হলে ডাক্তারের আদেশ-নির্দেশ যথাযথ মেনে চলা।

Weather Day temperature to remain unchanged

Rain or thundershower is likely to occur at many places over Chittagong division, at a few places over Dhaka-Rajshahi division and at one or two places over Khulna division during the next 24 hours commencing 6 am today (Saturday).

The Met office forecasts day temperature is likely to remain nearly unchanged all over the country. The country on Friday at many places experienced rainfall. The highest of 132 mm rainfall was reported from Cox's Bazar while Chittagong had 90 mm, Kutubdia 77 mm, Srimangal 37 mm, Sitakunda 22 mm, Maymensingh 12 mm, Teknaf and Sylhet 8 mm each and Comilla had 5 mm of rainfall.
