In Bangladesh everybody knows that political sabotage and terrorism have become a common reality. The fact is viewed as indifferently as the "universal truth" in narration in schools - the sun rises in the east. Now to this, add another universal truth — transport strike.

As is well-known, when the price of petrol and diesel is lessened, the transport authority will not lessen the bus fare accordingly, with the hope of greater and greater profit. And the strike is occasioned by such situations.

During the transport strike the suffering of the people is indescribable. It is greatest for the office-goers or people who have serious patients. Condition is very miserable for those who return from office at night. While they want to return home as early as possible, the rickshaws are less on the roads at such times.

People who have to traverse a long way are in great difficulty, because the rickshawwallahs do not want to go to distant places. Sometimes, occasional rain increases the trouble immeasurably. People cannot come out of the shed because of rain. They shout from there to bargain with the rickshawwallahs.

At the busy places like Farm Gate or Gulistan, situation is really unimaginable. Hundreds of people waiting on the road but there are only a very few rickshaws or babytaxis. When a rickshaw or a baby-taxi comes, a host of people fall upon it like madmen.

People keep standing to find rickshaw. At times, they feel tired, life seems to be full of ennui. Suddenly a private car passes filling these people's mind with impossible dreams of having car. They also dream that if, by miracle, some private car stops to him and the driver politely asks, "Where will you go?" But dream remains dream.

When there is transport strike, people usually go by rickshaw, Mishuk or baby-taxi. Sometimes they ride on 'van' (pulled) which presents a very pleasant sight. Seven or eight men on a van dangling their legs, talking jovially giving the impression that they are the happiest men in this world.

But it is the rickshaw which is used most. For the rickshawwallahs it is the heyday. He will bid exorbitant charge to the passengers. You will argue with him in every possible way to lessen the charge, but he will maintain his rigidness by showing an obstinate silence. However, people, on the other hand, have their own innocent defences. They go by 'share'. As a result of this share, you will frequently see such scenes that a man, who will go to Farm Gate, will sit on a rickshaw and the rickshawwallah will repeat Farm Gate, Farm Gate, Farm Gate Going by rickshaw brings people close. Two passengers who are unknown to each other suddenly start gossiping.

est at hand - transport strike. They will cynically talk about the transport workers and hurl abuse on the latter's fourteen generations.

The discussion then digresses from one subject to another. They sometimes start discussing the overall situation of the country and the comparison between the past and the present governments. Both of them know that what they are talking about has no important bearing on their life, but talk is the sweetest way in which people can pass their time. At the end of the discussion, sometimes they know the whereabouts of each other. They even go so far as to inquire about their per sonal address.

It is not very rare that occasionally rickshaw passengers in share become friends and the friendship lasts beyond the time of travelling. Thus it is amazing to note that transport strike which is the great generator of evils and sufferings, has within itself also an element of love that can bind people together. Well, life is a mass of contradictions and conflicts both in theory and practice.

In the transport strike period, a few longroute buses are moved within the city. In doing this, people of these buses take great risks. For, there are picketers lying in wait at the different turnings of the roads. They throw stones or cocktails at the buses. These buses, albeit very few, are of great help to the people. Naturally, they raise the bus-fare a little. Suppose. Tk 3 is demanded for travelling from Farm Gate to Gulistan, there are passengers who will even grudge paying this, whereas these same passengers would have to spend Tk 10 to 15 if they went by rickshaw or baby-taxi. So, that is the way with public life - give him an inch and the will take an ell.

As is known to everyone, in this period BRTC buses, which are government service, are on the move. But the number of these buses is infinitesimally small as compared to the number of people. Hence, the result is easily calculable. If you see such a bus with untold number of people, you will have an idea of how much condensable the human body can be!

Everybody loves life and how infinitely! But the passengers while jumping on BRTC buses become oblivious of the so lovable a thing as life. They literally stake their life and take the whole thing as a challenge.

It is worthy of attention that nowadays many people start movement, procession and strike over every trifle as it is their prerogative in this new democratic vista. They raise storm in a tea-cup. Transport strike is one of them. The conflict is between the lessening of the price of petrol-diesel and accordingly, the lessening of the bus-fare. But in all this, the common people are at the receiving end. So, it is the time that vox populi should protest against this


