11200 NGOs involved in non-formal edn programme

A meeting of the parliamentary standing committee on the Ministry of Education was held Sunday at Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban with Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar in the chair, reports BSS.

The meeting reviewed the progress of the mass education programme of the government in details. The meeting was informed that 43 upazilas of 38 districts have been covered by non-formal education programme and 69 upazilas would be brought under the programme in the coming year.

About 11200 NGOs are now involved actively in implementation of the programme.

Computerised telephone to replace coin-box

Coin-box system will be replaced with high-tech computerised telephone boxes in Dhaka and other major cities of the country. Telecommunications Minister Keramat Ali said in parliament Sunday, reports UNB.

Replying to a series of supplementaries from the treasury bench during the question hour, Ali said computerised card system telephone would be installed to stop malpractice in handling the coin-box telephones.

The minister assured the House that the government had planned to give extensive telelinks all over the country, including the offshore islands. The scheme will be implemented from next fiscal year.

Under the plan, 4,500 PCOs will be set up gradually in the country.

In reply to a question stood in the name of M Shamsul Haq of Awami League, the Telephone Minister said the government earned about Tk 12.44 lakh from 286 coin-box telephone sets in Dhaka city in the last (1991-92) fiscal year.

Flood forecast

Surma, Kushiara to take serious turn

The moderate flash flood in the Surma and the Kushiara basins may take a serious turn if the intensity of rain increases, experts feared Sunday, reports UNB.

According to official sources, about 300-700 millimeter rain has been recorded in Sylhet and Chittagong regions during the last 72 hours ending 6 am today.

Experts analysing the satellite pictures said heavy fall was also recorded in neighbouring areas of Assam, Sikkim and Behar in India in the Brahmaputra basin.

The downpour may continue for couple of days, but there would be no immediate deterioration of the situation, the experts said but suggested dissemination of all available information to concerned areas to be prepared for any unwarranted situation.

Heavy rainfall concentrated on places in northwestern part of the country during the last 24 hours. Significant fall of 172.5 mm was experienced at Dalia, 59 mm at Chilmari, 48 mm at Rangpur, 38 mm at Cox's Bazar, 36.7 mm at Panchagarh and 26.2 mm at Satkhira during the same period, Met office said.

Officials said all the rivers in the Meghna basin including Kushiara, Manu and Khowai were flowing below the danger level excepting the Surma flowing 36 centimeter above the danger level at Kanaighat and 21 cm at Shundmangj.

In its daily forecast, the Water Development Board said the rivers in Meghna basin were likely to mark further rise while low areas of Sylhet district would remain inundated.

The Ganges and the Brahmaputra are likely to rise further, the forecast said.

Officials said the Brahmaputra registered about 1.68 meter rise at Bahadurabad point in the last three days. The average rise in the river from Noonkhaowa to Aricha was 1.58 meter, lower than that of the same period last year.

The Brahmaputra also registered 43 centimeter rise at Chilmari, 48 centimeter at Sirajganj with the Teesta rising by 16 centimeter at Dalia while recorded slight fall at Kaunia. The Dharla at Kurigram rose 42 centimeter.

The Old Brahmaputra recorded a remarkable rise of 50 centimeter at Jamalpur and 74 centimeter at Mymensingh. Dhaka's Buriganga registered a rise by 27 centimeter and the Laksha at Narayanganj swelled 30 centimeter during the period.

All the rivers of the Brahmaputra basin were, however, flowing below the danger level.

Flood information centre of the Water Development Board said the Ganges also marked rise and would rise further but remain lower than the last year's level of the same period.

All the rivers of the Ganges basin were, however, flowing below the danger level when the report last came in.

It rose slightly at Pamkha and recorded remarkable rise by 19 centimeter at Rajshahi, 77 centimeter at Hardinge Bridge and 43 centimeter each at Goalanda and Bhagyakul.

The Karotoa at Panchagarh recorded a rise of 18 centimeter while Punarbhaha at Dinajpur, Mahananda at Chapainawabganj and the Jamuna at Naogaon marked slight rise.
