There are able many medical teachers who have retired from the government services at the age of 57 and have high academic qualification and vast experi ence. On the

other hand, the 1200 available seats are not enough for the thousands of students with high academic achievements in the SSC and HSC or equivalent levels. A large number of students are frustrated for being deprived of higher education opportunities. So there is no shortage of teachers and students for the medical graduate course in the country. Yet there exists a dearth of educational institutions

The executive council of Bangladesh Medical Studies and Research Institute has set up the Bangladesh Medical College in Dhanmondi.

Founded in 1984, the aim was of establish-

ing standard medical institutions. The first academic session started from July 1, 1987. The college was granted affiliation by the Dhaka University on the 10th May 1988. It follows all the rules and regulations, course and curriculum set by the Faculty of Medicine, Dhaka Uni-

## No change in day temperature

Moderate rain or showers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at many places over Chittagong, Khulna divisions and at a few places over Dhaka, Rajshahi divisions, during the next 24 hours commencing from 6 am today (Monday). Day temperature is likely to remain unchanged all over the country, according to Met office forecast.

No major change in weather will be noticed in the next two days, the Met office said adding that rain activities are likely to decrease after five days.

The country at many places experienced rainfall yesterday (Sunday) from 6 am to 6 pm. The highest rainfall of 33 mm was reported from Faridpur, while Satkhira had 32 mm, Teknaf 25 mm, Jessore 15 mm and Cox's Bazar had 9 mm of rainfall.

The highest temperature of 32.6 degree Celsius was reported from Khulna on Sunday and the lowest of 21.4 degree was reported from Chittagong.
