

He said for the Americans the 4th of July is a special celebration of "Who we are as a nation, and what we stand for." He said "While our two nations are different in many ways, the principles which govern the United States freedom and democracy - are the same in Bangladesh.'

"Americans celebrate those values today, and Americans welcome their extension in Bangladesh," Milam said.


IUTA condemns suspension of answer script checking


