

Date of payment of Titas gas bill extended

The Titas Gas Transmission and Distribution Company Limited has extended the last date for payment of gas bills (without surcharge) till July 15, reports BSS.

A company press release said the non-payment of the gas bills till May 1992 within the rescheduled deadline would follow disconnection of the lines.

It said the new date had been reflected at the request of the subscribers.

Govt plans to set up tourism centres in Sundarbans

The State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism, Abdul Mannan, yesterday informed the Jatiya Sangsad that the government was considering to set up tourism centres at different places around the Sundarbans, reports BSS.

Replying to a call attention notice moved by Jamaat member Sheikh Anwar Ali, the State Minister said a team from the World Tourism Organisation had completed a survey study in the Sundarbans and the adjoining areas from June 24 to July 4 for providing tourism facilities there.

He said the government would take up a tourism development programme on the basis of the survey report.

Regarding the demand for setting up a tourism centre at Munshiganj under Shyamnagar thana under Sathkhira district, the State Minister urged the private entrepreneurs including those from the Jamaat to come up in building infrastructure including construction of hotels, motels and other facilities there.

He requested the Ministry of Communication to construct a road from Shyamnagar to Munshiganj and the Ministry of Energy to bring Munshiganj under electricity supply.
