Stern action against toll-collectors urged

Transport workers' leaders Thursday urged the government to take stern measures against the toll collectors and 'mastans' to save the transport sector and for the sake of a healthy trade union system.

The leaders who opposed the last month's strike alleged that the strike was called to rehabilitate some mastans in different bus terminals but the government had not yet taken any step against them.

Addressing the several hundred workers rally, Manzurul Ahsan Khan, Executive President of Bangladesh Road Transport Workers Federation, accused that a section of ruling party labour leaders were also involved in the strike during which several people were killed and hundreds others injured.

"The strikers demanded acquittal of the accused of Grindlays Bank dacoity case without trial, lease of Gabtali

cattle market, and the terminals for free toll collections," Khan accused adding that "trade unions and its leadership are used as a source of income of vested quarters."

"We started a crusade that the name of the transport workers should not be used to take the country people hostages and for the interest of vested quarters," he said.

He also said the people got a bad impression about the transport workers because of frequent strikes and anarchy but most of the strikes failed to realise the demands of the workers.

Presided over by Abdur Rouf, President of Paribahan Sramik Union the rally was addressed, among others were Abdur Khaled, Abdur Wadud Nayan, Shahidullah, Yakub Ali, Ali Reza, Abdur Kadir and Litu.

Dhaka WASA earns Tk 44.01 crore last year

Dhaka WASA earned Tk 44.01 crore in revenue during the last fiscal year as realisation of overdue bills picked up due to certain measures, reports UNB.

Of the amount, Tk 12.43 crore was realised from the public and Tk 31.58 crore from the private sector, official sources said.

The revenue collection in 1991-92 was 17 per cent higher than that of previous fiscal year (1990-91) when the earning was Tk 37.95 crore.

The collection was out of the total Tk 48.44 crore due from various government and non-government organisations.

With the rise in revenue receipt due to a special drive in May-June last, the total outstanding amount came down to Tk 26 crore from Tk 30 crore.
