

Work for Khulna town protection to begin soon

Work for Khulna town protection sub-project under the Asian Development Bank (ADB) aided secondary towns integrated flood protection project will begin this fiscal year at a

cost of Taka 3843.10 lakh, reports BSS.

It was stated by Agriculture, Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-Ul Haq while replying to a question from Abdul Khaleq Talukdar (AL-Bagerhat) at the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

The minister said Taka 222 lakh had been sanctioned for the current fiscal year of the six-year sub-project. This year's works under the sub-project included alternative embankment at Kazibachha and protective works in the Roseveit jetty portion and Ahutala site, he added.

Huq also informed the House that a total of Taka 909.55 lakh was spent till June 1992 under the Khulna town protection project that started in September 1980 involving Taka 4075.30 lakh. The Khulna city stands on the right side of the rivers Bhairab and Rupsa.

This was stated by the speakers at a seminar yesterday on "Organisational and educational training for women leadership" jointly organised by Bangladesh Teachers Union (BTA) and International Federation for Female Teachers Union (IFFTU) at K L Jubilee School and College auditorium.

State Minister for Education Principal Yunus Khan inaugurated the seminar

as the chief guest. Presided over by the president of BTA and SAARC teachers organisation Quamruzzaman, the opening session of the seminar was addressed, among others, by the representative of IFFTU for Asia and the Pacific region Gurnam Singh, organiser Karuna Kumari, and Choudhury Khurshid Alam of BTA.

Speaking on the occasion, the State Minister called upon the women professionals, particularly those who are involved in teaching, to come forward with specific development programmes for the promotion of women's role in the nation building activities.

Khan appreciated the arrangement of the seminar and hoped that such initiatives will help Bangladeshi women teachers in playing greater role in the international arena for the development of the country.

Gurnam Singh said increased number of women had been involving themselves in different professional fields in the recent periods and due to this the need for promotion of women leadership was emphasised throughout the world.

He called for organising a SAARC regional women's conference to solve the problems of the women community of the region.

In his presidential speech, Quamruzzaman said the female teachers of the country were the most conscious women of the country. Promotion of

women leadership in organisational and educational fields was a must for the overall development of the country, he said.

The seminar was attended by 40 participants from the different districts besides delegates from India and Malaysia.

Madrasa students to build movement on 10-point demand

Bangladesh Madrasa Chhatra Andolan Parishad (MCAP) in a rally yesterday announced the decision to build a vigorous movement to press home its 10-point demand, reports UNB.
