**'Vocational training for womenfolk
needed for self-employment'**

Minister for Social Welfare and Women's Affairs M Tariqul Islam underscored the need for imparting vocational training to the womenfolk to create self-employment opportunities, reports BSS.

The overall socio-economic

development of the country would not be attained without improving the lot of the womenfolk, who constitute about 50 per cent of the total population, Islam said.

Inaugurating a training course on computer for women organised by the Jatiya Mahila Sangstha in cooperation with WISTAR (Women in Science and Technology in Asian Region), a non-governmental organisation the Minister said the present BNP government had undertaken a massive programme for alleviation of poverty through education for women, human resources development and population planning activities.

Islam said it was President Ziaur Rahman who for the first time visualised that the country's socio-economic objectives could not be achieved without

involving womenfolk with the mainstream of development.

State Minister for Social Welfare and Women's Affairs Begum Sarwari Rahman, Vice-Chancellor of the Open University and eminent scientist Dr Shamsheer Ali, Secretary of the Ministry of Social Welfare and Women's Affairs Enamul Haque and Executive Director of WISTAR Dr Shahida Rahman also addressed the function held at the office premises of the sangstha at Eskaton.

Chairperson of Jatiya Mahila Sangstha Begum Selina Rahman MP presided over the function. Appreciating the Jatiya Mahila Sangstha for organising the computer training course for women, Islam said similar programmes were also being run by the Directorate of Women's Affairs.

CHTNCPC

Leaders of Chittagong Hill Tracts National Coordination and Peace Council (CHTNCPC) Thursday in a joint statement said that although the leaders of the ruling and the opposition parties in the parliament agreed to find a political solution to the problems of the hill tracts, none was coming up with a practical plan to make it real.

They said, every body was looking forward to the political solution of the area and the government was not acting promptly. They added along with other problems, terrorism was still on increase in the region.

**Guidelines for training,
