

Call to stop Matamuhuri erosion at Kakara

CHITTAGONG, July 21: Azur Rahman, ex-MP and President, and Alhaj Anwar Husain, General Secretary, respectively of Chakaria Upazila Samity here today called upon the government to take immediate measures to stop change of course by the river Matamuhuri at Kakara, two miles upstream from Chittagong-Cox's Bazar road at Cheringa.

In a statement they said, continuous erosion by the river Matamuhuri at Kakara has posed a serious threat to the existence of the village Kakara, Chittagong-Cox's Bazar road near Shaker Muhammad Char and Chakaria Degree College as well as the school area at Cheringa.

The river Matamuhuri first changed its course in 1963 devouring a portion of Chittagong-Cox's Bazar road and entire Chakaria Model High school area at Cheringa.

FAO cooperation assured

Lauding the role of Bangladesh in the NAM, she said that the forthcoming summit would foster further the unity among the Non-aligned nations and assert to resolve the problems faced by them.

No small pox patient in country: Kamal

A total of 7,224 people have been attacked by chicken pox upto May this year, Health Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yousuf told Parliament yesterday, reports UNB.

Replying to Sharfuddin Khasru, the minister said there are, however, no small pox patient in the country.

In reply to Shahadatuzaman, the minister said the government has no stock of ambulance at present. The same would be provided in phases if it is provided as grant by any donor country or agency, he said.

The minister also informed the House that there are 2,661 posts of health assistants in the country. The government has a plan to fill up these posts and measures are being taken in this regard, he told the questioner Principal Nazrul Islam.

BFUJ, DUJ leaders criticise attack on Banglar Bani office

Leaders of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) in a joint statement Tuesday criticised the attack of the office of Banglar Bani Monday by some unruly elements while proceeding to Motijheel after a meeting of Jubo Command at Dainik Bangla square, reports BSS.

Describing the attacks as naked aggression on the freedom of newsmen and newspaper, the union leaders maintained that such attack would create obstacles to healthy journalism.
