**World body urged to give priority to disaster preparedness**

Bangladesh has called upon the world body to ensure the linkage between immediate humanitarian relief, rehabilitation and long-term development for lasting solution of the problems confronted by the disaster prone countries, according to a message received here from New York, reports BSS.

Addressing the on-going ECOSOC session yesterday afternoon Ambassador Humayun Kabir, the leader of Bangladesh delegation and permanent representative of Bangladesh to the UN stressed that adequate disaster preparedness should also receive high priority as it can greatly reduce the effects of disaster. Giving a brief resume of measures undertaken by the present government for permanent solutions of natural disasters in Bangladesh following the worst cyclone of the century last year, Ambassador Kabir said, it was our hope that the UN would be able to play its due role with despatch and compassion in a coordinated way through its operational agencies and a catalyst for efforts by the governments donors and others. In this connection the Bangladesh permanent representative extends full support to the humanitarian efforts of the UN and welcomed the new department on UN humanitarian affairs.

**Regional workshop ends Bangladesh will undertake research on jackfruits**

A three-day regional workshop on "The utilisation of under-exploited fruits and nuts in Asia" ended in Dhaka yesterday with the adoption of a set of recommendations suggesting extensive cultivation of the fruits, reports BSS.

The participants to the workshop from Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Malaysia and Sri Lanka and resource persons from the UK agreed to collaborate with each other through a research network to be established jointly by Commonwealth Science Council (CSC) and International Centre for Under-Utilised Crops (ICUC) UK.

The net-work will initially be coordinated from the UK. The five countries from the region agreed to develop research programme in parallel with the constraints on production and marketing of five under-utilised fruits species on priority basis.

Under the programme, Bangladesh will undertake research work on processing and marketing of jack-fruits, India-bur, Malaysia- mangosteen, Pakistan- guava and Sri Lanka-anona species of fruits.

The concluding session was presided over by the Chairman of Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council (BARC), M. Sujayet Ullah Chowdhury. The recommendations were introduced by Dr. Nazmul Haq of the ICUC and Dr. Peter de Groot of the CSC which were unanimously accepted.

In addition to agreed recommendations, the participants dwelt at length on the prospect of promotion of traditional and under- exploited fruits and nuts in Asia.

They also examined the feasibility of exploring technology for processing of seasonal fruits for marketing at home, regional and international markets.

During the deliberations in the last three days, the participants laid stress on taking up national programme for increasing the cultivation of

fruits and nuts for meeting nutritional deficiency and increasing food value in their respective countries.

In the field of fruits cultivation and their marketing abroad, Malaysia had made a breakthrough. The Malaysian participant, Dr. M Osman, said his country was earning 250 million US dollars from exporting fresh and processed fruits and nuts annually.

India and Pakistan had also attained substantial success in the promotion of fruits cultivation followed by Sri Lanka. In Bangladesh, the capita consumption of fruits had reduced considerably due to rapid increase in the growth of population.

Dr. KM Badruddoza, scientist emeritus of Bangladesh who participated in the workshop told BSS that such type of workshop in Asia was new. He hoped that the deliberations in the workshop would help to a great extent in popularising the cultivation of traditional fruits in Asia.
