enue (NBR) collected a total of Taka 3192 crore as VAT, excise and supplementary duties during the last fiscal year, exceeding the budgetary target According to the official figures, revenue collection from these categories showed an upward trend during the period compared to a collection of Taka 2545 crore from the same items in 1990-91 and in some cases even surpassed the

However, a Finance Ministry source pointed out that internal VAT collection was "not upto the mark due to noncompliance by the service and some manufacturing sectors and also because of administrative lapses." VAT was imposed at a flat rate of 15 per cent on manufactured and imported items and on a selected number of service sectors from July 1 last

Many of the service sectors which came under VAT, including sweetmeat shops, indenting houses, video rental and video-audio recording shops, motor garages, auctioncers and film and photography studios, failed to enlist with

the authorities and did not pay any VAT during the period, the Ministry source added. He said that the adminis-

trative lapse in the collection of VAT was primarily due to inadequate manpower and also because the VAT administration was not reorganised according to the requirements. "The administration has to be further strengthened in order to enhance VAT collection," he added.
