Following the publicity, the society pointed out, many blood pressure patients gave up medicine prescribed by doctors and took up the balancer. The society told the press that the private firm neither could produce any scientific document in favour of the basis of such treatment, nor did they pass the product in the market through proper clinical trial. The society urged concerned authority to stop publicity and marketing of such product.
