Export fails to reach revised target, says EPB statistics

The country earned 1993.09 million US dollars, equivalent to Tk 7587.71 crore, from its export sector in fiscal 1991-92, according to the final official estimates, reports UNB. The earnings registered a shortfall of 0.35 per cent of the revised target of 2,000 million US dollars for the year but, showed 16.04 per cent increase over the earnings of the previous 1990-91 fiscal. The figures were revealed in the 67th meeting of the Managing Council of the Export Promotion Bureau (EPB) which appraised last year's export performance here yesterday. The meeting reviewed that major exportables including jute, frozen foods, tea, leather and items under crash programme failed to fetch their projected earnings. Agricultural commodities, chemical products, engineer-

ing items and readymade garments, however, were able to touch or cross their targets. Major importing countries during 1991-92 were: United States, Germany, UK, France, Iran, Belgium, Netherlands, Japan, Singapore, India, China and Pakistan. The meeting discussed export prospect of some twelve items under crash programme.

Biswas stresses need for technical education

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday emphasised the need for technical education, particularly the textile engineering and technology for achieving self-reliance in textile sector, reports BSS. He said the nation would earn self sufficiency in all aspects by utilizing the modern science and technology.

The President was addressing the students of Bangladesh College of Textile Engineering and Technology when they came to meet him at Bangladesh. President Biswas said priority should be given to improve the lot of the backward sections of the society who live in rural areas. He also laid emphasis on massive training programme for the women of the country.
