Alam gets int'l photography award

The award, one of the most prestigious in international photography, includes a cash of \$7000. The awarded work will be included in an exhibition, organised by the FNAC company in Paris that begins in the spring in 1993 and travel for a year to several galleries in Belgium and France.

The four other winners of this year's award are Nickos Economopoulos of Greece, Vivian Moos of the United States, Francisco Matos Rosa of Mexico, and Santo Mofokeng from Africa.

Alam has also been offered a scholarship to attend a workshop next month to learn the recent advances in interfaces between photography and computers by the Centre for Creative Imaging in Camden, Maine, USA. Alam is the first South Asian to win the award.
