Jute assoc urges withdrawal of VAT

By Staff Correspondent Bangladesh Jute Association(BJA) urged the government on Monday to withdraw the Value Added Tax(VAT) from the insurance of jute

The BJA at a meeting of its executive body alleged that the government was discouraging the traders by imposing tax and VAT on various sectors of jute trade.

It said that the government had recently made the insurance for flood and natural disaster compulsory for the storage of jute, for which the traders would have to give five per cent to eleven per cent additional premium to the insurance companies with the previous amount for fire insurance. It also imposed 15 per cent VAT on the fire insur ance, the BJA added.

The association, however, urged the government to cover the risk of flood and natural disaster alongwith the fire with the previous amount of premium.


