Jute assoc urges withdrawal of VAT

By Staff Correspondent Bangladesh Jute Association (BJA) urged the government on Monday to withdraw the Value Added Tax (VAT) from the insurance of jute trade.

The BJA at a meeting of its executive body alleged that the government was discouraging the traders by imposing tax and VAT on various sectors of jute trade.

It said that the government had recently made the insurance for flood and natural disaster compulsory for the storage of jute, for which the traders would have to give five per cent to eleven per cent additional premium to the insurance companies with the previous amount for fire insurance. It also imposed 15 per cent VAT on the fire insurance, the BJA added.

The association, however, urged the government to cover the risk of flood and natural disaster along with the fire with the previous amount of premium.

Memorandum submitted BCU demands Home Minister's replacement

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) Monday submitted a memorandum to the Director General of Education demanding fulfillment of a 10-point demand of school students, reports UNB.

The demand includes: setting up of Shaheed Minar in all schools, free education, establishment of at least one boys' and one girls' school in every thana, supply of educational materials at reasonable prices and concession in transport fares, increase of students' scholarships and immediate reduction of newspaper prices.

Before submitting the memorandum, the pro-CPB BCU organised a rally in front of the Shikha Bhaban with its city unit President Pathik Shaha in the chair.

The gathering was addressed among others by central acting President Shahidul Islam Lito, General Secretary Ruhin Hassan Prince, School Students' Affairs Secretary Sarcar Rakibuddin and Shariful Arif Sohel.
