City will get facelift for SAARC summit

City fathers have planned to 'beautify' the capital in preparation for the seventh SAARC summit, and a high-level committee has been given the job to explore ideas for decoration of Dhaka.

Mayor Mirza Abbas chaired a meeting of senior officials Saturday and formed the committee headed by Rajdhani Unnayan Katiripakkhya (RAJUK) chairman Anwarul Alam.

The meeting, attended by summit preparatory committee chief Faruq Ahmed Chowdhury, officials from the Foreign Ministry, the Public Works Department, RAJUK, Dhaka City Corporation, Parjatan Corporation, asked the Alam-led body to submit its recommendations by this Saturday.

The Mayor sits with the officials again on Monday to discuss the proposals.

Last Saturday's meeting decided to explore possibilities to set up something symbolic at the Noor Hossain Square, overlooking the Osmany Memorial Hall, the venue for the opening and closing ceremonies. The ideas has been conceived to project the present democratic spirit.

Film producer Mustafiz dies

Noted film producer and director Mustafizur Rahman died at the Holy Family Hospital here yesterday morning after a protracted illness. He was 64, reports BSS.

Rahman, who was a former president of Bangladesh Film Producers Association, produced and directed many films including 'Harano Din', 'Maia', 'Chhota Sahab', 'Talaish', 'Dak Babu' and under production 'Sonya'.

He left behind his wife, three sons, one daughter, grandsons and daughters and a host of relatives and friends.

He was buried at the Banani graveyard following janazas at the FDC premises and Baitul Mokarram mosque.

Bangladesh Film Producers Association has expressed deep shock at the death of the pioneer film personality and conveyed sympathy to the bereaved family.

USIS worldnet television programme

Stronger economic reforms needed to attract foreign capital : Simmons

The economic reforms that have swept South Asia need to be bolstered even further, if the region is to succeed in attracting foreign capital in today's competitive global economy, according to Jhon Simmons, an international trade specialist at the US Commerce Department, reports UNB.

Simmons was speaking in a USIS Worldnet television programme with guests in Dhaka, Bombay and Colombo.

He fielded questions from Dhaka by Monzor Elahi, Chairman of Apex Group of Industries and SH Kabir, Managing Director of Pfizer Pharmaceuticals.

Kabir began the programme from Dhaka by asking how Bangladesh could attract investment given the global competition for investment money.

Simmons noted that Bangladesh has taken 'difficult and significant steps' but stressed the need for continued moves toward liberal trade regime.

He suggested that Bangladesh focus on its strengths, such as cheap labour. He cautioned that changing to a market-oriented and business-friendly economy was not a quick process, but one that required commitment and perseverance that would bear fruit over time.

"You really have to start somewhere... Bangladesh needs to start the process and meet challenges," he said.

Elahi asked several political questions concerning trade delegations to the US. Simmons urged that Bangladesh businessmen put together delegations that focus on one area only, such as leather goods, rather than putting a number of different business in the same group.

He also suggested that trade groups contact American trade associations and the Bangladesh embassy in Washington to seek assistance in arranging meetings with American businessmen.
