10 quit race 66 to contest in JU senate polls

JU Correspondent Ten out of 76 nominees to Jahangirnagar University Senate withdrew their nomination papers yesterday, the last date for withdrawal. Six candidates will be contesting for the posts of dean of three faculties while 66 competitors will now vie for the 33 teacher representatives to senate polls scheduled to be held on August 18.

Meanwhile, electioneering in the campus is in full-swing. Most of the candidates and their supporters were seen busy with lobbying.

Candidates are reportedly contesting from two panels - one of which is said to be backed by Vice Chancellor. A senate candidate from the teachers' quota, preferring anonymity, told the Daily Star that the unification of two out of three factions has put the anti-VC group in a better position.

The anti-VC group has taken a strong stand against fundamentalism and corruption, while the opposing group accused their rival of patronising fundamentalists.

Dr. Nurul Islam, dean candidate to the Arts and Humanities faculty accused the administration of misusing power. 'The authorities have made fresh recruitment of seven teachers in four departments on adhoc basis prior to the election just for voting,' he said.

The Vice Chancellor, however, said that these appointments were made in recommendations of the present deans and chairmen of the faculties.

Nirmul body to continue movement against Azam

Ekattorer Ghatak Dalal Nirmul Committee brought out a procession yesterday protesting 'the conspiracy to send Golam Azam out of the country' before trying him as a war criminal. Before the procession a leader of Nirmul Committee Shahriar Kabir at a rally said that such conspiracy was formulated to save Golam Azam from the punishment he deserved as a war criminal.

Talking to the Daily Star, Convener of the Nirmul Committee Jahanara Imam said the committee was vigorously organising a continued movement to press home its demands. 'She said the Nirmul Committee would continue its peaceful ways until it was forced to adopt different ways. The procession was headed by leaders of the organisation including Nayeem Jahangir, Kamal Hossain Badal, Obaydul Haq Obayed and Taher Ahmed.

Ispahani Degree College to be nationalised

Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar yesterday called upon the students to put in their efforts to restore academic atmosphere on the campus, reports BSS. He said the government was aiming at making the students worthy citizens. The Education Minister was speaking as chief guest at the installation ceremony of the students union of Ispahani Degree College at Keraniganj. Presided over by Principal of the College M Shahjahan, the function was addressed by State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism M A Mannan, State Minister for Law and Justice Aminul Hoq, local MP Amanullah Aman and BNP leader Prof Mohiuddin Ahmed. The Education Minister said BNP government had already taken pragmatic steps towards bringing about a qualitative change in the education system for catering the needs of the people. He added that the government would follow some principles in the process of nationalisation of schools and colleges. Ispahani Degree College will be nationalised in the first phase of nationalisation programme, he added. He pointed out that the government had already launched a massive programme for eradicating illiteracy by the year 2000. Barrister Sircar said rule of law is an imperative for national development and democracy. He also urged the students to help establish the rule of law by resisting violence. The Education Minister handed over a cheque for Taka one lakh and 50 thousand donated by the Prime Minister for development work of the college.

Distribution of khas land suggested

Bangladesh Nationalist Landless Welfare Parishad yesterday suggested distribution of khas land among the real landless for their rehabilitation, reports BSS. Parishad leader Sefayet Ullah Patwari told a press conference here that about 60 per cent of the country's population is landless living under poverty line. Patwari said his organisation would take initiative for preparing lists of the landless people scattering across the country. He also stressed the need for successful implementation of the family planning programmes.

RU medical centre facing problems

RAJSHAHI, Aug 11: Rajshahi University medical centre is beset with multifarious problems for a long time, reports UNB. Only 71 doctors are employed for the treatment of about 20 thousand students, teachers, officers, employees and their families. Shortage of required medicine is the main problem in the centre. Patients have to wait in long queue and return with only a few common tablets. Patients are being deprived of proper treatment due to insufficient supply of medical instrument, medicines and other facilities. General students complain that the doctors and other employees often neglect the patients. Students demanded a general hospital to be set up in the university area.

Dateline Rajshahi Durgapur thana needs electricity

RAJSHAHI, Aug 11: Durgapur thana in the district is still out of the network of rural electrification which is essential for irrigation and running small factories, reports UNB. Apart from the thana headquarters, vast village areas and small markets are yet to find electric light to replace kerosene lamps. Irri-boro paddy has now emerged as the main crops in the thana, as elsewhere in the district and the northern region at large. And the dry season high yielding variety (HYV) of paddy cultivation heavily depends on irrigation by means of pumping out sub-soil water with thousands of pumps like shallow and deep tubewells. In absence of power supply to the rural areas of Durgapur, the farmers have to operate their machines with the high-price fuel oil. Some times, they cannot afford to buy oil, and their crops wither away for want of water. This year, many farmers had to abandon their schemes or squeeze acreage of the paddy cultivation for exorbitant price of oil. Irrigation is costlier and more difficult in these areas than other parts of the country because of scorching summer and recurring drought. Moreover, small factories cannot grow in the village markets. Some machines are operate in these markets with diesel.

1049 arrested

BSS adds: Police have launched drive to nab the anti-social elements from different parts of Rajshahi region, official sources said. The police have arrested 1049 persons till Sunday from 16 northern districts for their alleged involvement in various crimes. The drive named 'Operation-92' will continue. Some arms and ammunition were also recovered, the source said. Speakers at a rally called upon the people to curb terrorism and violence unitedly, for greater national interest. The rally organised by Rajshahi District Jatyatabadi Chhatra Dal was held at Shaheb Bazar square Monday afternoon. Call to raise population issue in SAARC summit


